1 Ball (N)
- 860-153 Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Yarn: Black
1 Ball (O)
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9 [5.5 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

15 sts + 28 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. 20 Squares are knit, changing yarn color to make stripes.
2. Change yarn color by dropping the old color and begin working with the new color, leaving long yarn tails to weave in later.
3. Squares are sewn together following a diagram to make Afghan.



SQUARE 1

With H, cast on 38 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every row) for 70 rows, changing color as follows:

With H, work 10 rows.
With I, work 10 rows.
With K, work 26 rows.
With M, work 8 rows.
With O, work 8 rows.
With N, work 8 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 2

With J, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With J, work 24 rows.
With I, work 24 rows.
With G, work 22 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 3

With C, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With C, work 12 rows.
With H, work 8 rows.
With K, work 8 rows.
With A, work 8 rows.
With O, work 12 rows.
With N, work 22 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 4

With N, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With N, work 42 rows.
With B, work 28 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 5

With H, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With H, work 30 rows.
With J, work 16 rows.
With A, work 8 rows.
With C, work 8 rows.
With M, work 8 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 6

With M, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With M, work 30 rows.
With F, work 20 rows.
With B, work 10 rows.
With A, work 10 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 7

With B, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With B, work 24 rows.

With E, work 24 rows.
With M, work 22 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 8

With G, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With G, work 40 rows.
With J, work 10 rows.
With K, work 10 rows.
With N, work 10 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 9

With G, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With G, work 40 rows.
With B, work 10 rows.
With C, work 8 rows.
With I, work 6 rows.
With A, work 6 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 10

With E, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With E, work 22 rows.
With J, work 16 rows.
With K, work 32 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 11

With D, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With D, work 24 rows.
With L, work 24 rows.
With A, work 22 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 12

With E, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With E, work 30 rows.
With G, work 20 rows.
With A, work 20 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 13

With K, cast on 38 sts.
Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:
With K, work 24 rows.
With C, work 24 rows.
With L, work 22 rows.
Bind off.

SQUARE 14

With M, cast on 38 sts.

Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:

With M, work 26 rows.

With C, work 10 rows.

With F, work 10 rows.

With L, work 10 rows.

With I, work 6 rows.

With N, work 4 rows.

With J, work 4 rows.

Bind off.

SQUARE 15

With F, cast on 38 sts.

Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:

With F, work 46 rows.

With D, work 24 rows.

Bind off.

SQUARE 16

With H, cast on 38 sts.

Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:

With H, work 16 rows.

With F, work 10 rows.

With N, work 10 rows.

With D, work 34 rows.

Bind off.

SQUARE 17

With I, cast on 38 sts.

Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:

With I, work 32 rows.

With B, work 38 rows.

Bind off.

SQUARE 18

With D, cast on 38 sts.

Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:

With D, work 8 rows.

With C, work 8 rows.

With M, work 8 rows.

With L, work 30 rows.

With J, work 8 rows.

With I, work 8 rows.

Bind off.

SQUARE 19

With A, cast on 38 sts.

Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:

With A, work 46 rows.

With D, work 24 rows.

Bind off.

SQUARE 20

With O, cast on 38 sts.

Work in Garter st for 70 rows, changing color as follows:

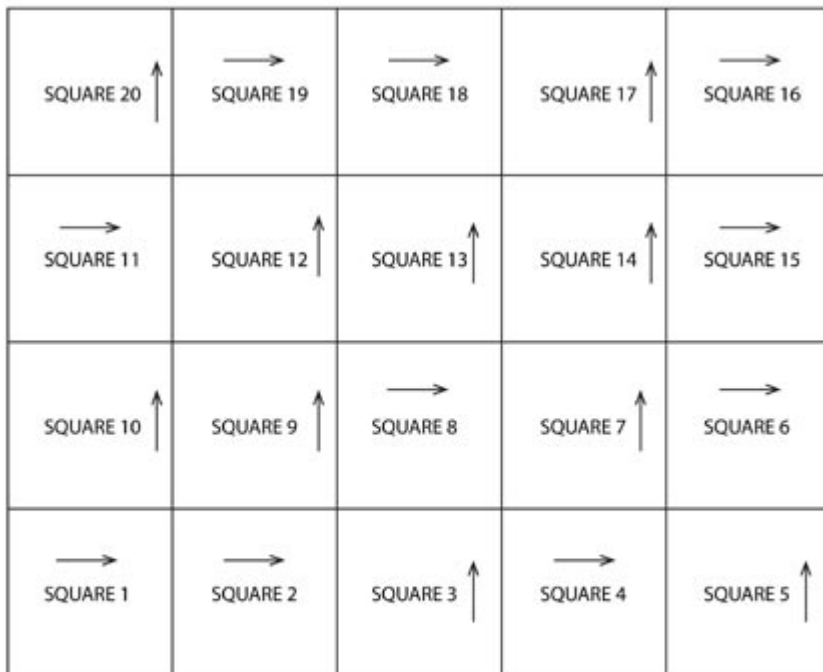
With O, work 8 rows.

With N, work 8 rows.

With G, work 12 rows.

With A, work 42 rows.
Bind off.

FINISHING Following arrows on diagram for direction of Squares, sew Squares into 4 strips of 5 Squares each. Sew strips together to make Afghan.
Weave in ends.
