- 486-123 <u>Lion Brand LB</u> <u>Collection Superwash</u> <u>Merino: Hemp</u> 1 Ball (A)
- 486-107 <u>Lion Brand LB</u> <u>Collection Superwash</u> <u>Merino Yarn: Sky</u> 1 Ball (B)
- 486-108 <u>Lion Brand LB</u> <u>Collection Superwash</u> <u>Merino Yarn: Denim</u> 1 Ball (C)
- 486-149 <u>Lion Brand LB</u> <u>Collection Superwash</u> <u>Merino: Charcoal</u> 1 Ball (D)

• Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

GAUGE:

18 sts + 30 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Block 1 pattern with 1 strand each of A and I held together.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:


1. Cowl is worked in one piece.

2. Stitches are picked up along edges of Triangles to work the next Triangle or Block. A diagram is provided to help you visualize the process.

3. Each Block and Triangle is worked with multiple strands of yarn held together. Read

instructions carefully for the correct number of strands and colors used in each block. Wind F into 4 separate balls before beginning.

4. Carry color(s) not in use along side edge of piece unless instructed to cut. When instructed to cut color, leave ends long enough to weave in later.



COWL

Note: Always sl sts as if to purl.
Block 1
With 1 strand each of A and I held tog, cast on 36 sts.
Row 1: Sl 1, knit to end of row.
Change to 1 strand each of D and H held tog.
Rep Row 1 changing colors as follows: work (2 rows with 1 strand each of D and H held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand each of A and I held tog) 9 times.
Cut A, I, D and H.

Triangle 1

Row 1 (Dec-RS): With 1 strand each of C and G held together, sl 1, k2tog, k to end of row.
Next Row: Sl 1, k to end of row.
Rep last 2 rows until 3 sts rem.
Next Row: K3tog.
Cut C and G.

Triangle 2

From RS, with 4 strands of F held tog, pick up and k45 sts evenly spaced along diagonal edge of Triangle 1.
Row 1: SI 1, knit to end of row.
Rows 2 and 3 (Dec): With 1 strand each of C and G held tog, sl 1, k2tog, k to end of row.
Rows 4 and 5: With 4 strands of F held tog, rep Rows 2 and 3.
Rep Rows 2-5 until 3 sts rem.
Next Row: With 4 strands of F held tog, k3tog.
Cut C and G.

Block 2

From RS, with 4 strands of F held tog, pick up and k36 sts across ends of rows of Triangle 2.
Row 1: Sl 1, k to end of row.
Rows 2-34: Rep Row 1.
Cut 3 strands of F, leave 1 strand of F uncut for Triangle 3.

Triangle 3

Row 1 (Dec-RS): With 1 strand each of A and I held tog, sl 1, k2tog, k to end of row.
Row 2: Sl 1, k to end of row.
Rows 3 and 4: With 1 strand each of E and F held tog, rep Rows 1 and 2.
Rep Rows 1-4 until 3 sts rem.
Next Row: With 1 strand each of E and F held tog, k3tog.
Cut A, I, E and F.

Triangle 4

From RS, with 1 strand each of E and H held tog, pick up and k45 sts evenly spaced along diagonal edge of Triangle 3.

Row 1 (Dec): SI 1, k2tog, k to end of row. Rep Row 1 until 3 sts rem. Next Row: K3tog. Cut E and H.

Block 3

From RS, with 1 strand each of B and G held tog, pick up and k36 sts across ends of rows of Triangle 4. **Row 1:** SI 1, k to end of row.

Change to 1 strand each of E and H held tog.

Rep Row 1 changing color as follows: work (2 rows with 1 strand each of E and H held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand each of B and G held tog) 9 times.

Cut E and H.

Triangle 5

Row 1 (Dec-RS): With 1 strand each of B and G held tog, sl 1, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.
Row 2: Sl 1, k to end of row.
Rep Rows 1 and 2 until 3 sts rem.
Next Row: K3tog.

Triangle 6

From RS, with 1 strand each of A and I held tog, pick up and k45 sts evenly spaced along diagonal edge of Triangle 5.
Row 1: SI 1, k to end of row.
Rows 2 and 3 (Dec): With 1 strand each of B and G held tog, sl 1, k2tog, k to end of row.
Rows 4 and 5: With 1 strand each of A and I held tog, rep Rows 2 and 3.
Rep Rows 2-5 until 3 sts rem.
Next Row: With B and G, k3tog.
Cut B and G.

Block 4

From RS, with 1 strand each of A and I held tog, pick up and k36 sts across ends of rows of Triangle 6. **Row 1:** SI 1, k to end of row. **Rows 2-34:** Rep Row 1.

Triangle 7

Row 1 (Dec-RS): With 1 strand each of D and H held tog, sl 1, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.
Row 2: Sl 1, k to end of row.
Rows 3 and 4: With 1 strand each of A and I held tog, rep Rows 1 and 2.
Rep Rows 1-4 until 3 sts rem.
Next Row: With 1 strand each of A and I held tog, k3tog.
Cut A and I.

Triangle 8

From RS, with 1 strand each of D and H held tog, pick up and k45 sts evenly spaced along diagonal edge of Triangle 7. **Row 1 (Dec):** SI 1, k2tog, k to end of row.

Rep Row 1 until 3 sts rem. Next Row: K3tog. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew ends of piece tog to make Cowl. Weave in ends.
