- 486-194 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> <u>Superwash Merino: Acid Green</u>
 1 Ball (A)
- 486-145 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> Superwash Merino: Eggplant
 - 1 Ball (B)
- 486-123 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> <u>Superwash Merino: Hemp</u>
 - 1 Ball (C)
- 484-157 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> <u>Silk Mohair Yarn: Sunbeam</u>
 - 1 Ball (D)
- 484-147 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> Silk Mohair Yarn: Iris
 - 1 Ball (E)
- 484-100 <u>Lion Brand LB Collection</u> <u>Silk Mohair Yarn: Wisp</u>
 - 1 Ball (F)
- <u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles-</u> <u>Size 8 [5 mm]</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> Needles (Set of 6)

*LB Collection Superwash Merino (Article #486). 100% Superwash Merino Wool; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (306yds/280m) pull skeins



*LB Collection Silk Mohair (Article #484). 70% Super Kid Mohair, 30% Silk; package size: 0.88oz/25.00 gr. (231yds/212m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

16 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-14 with 1 strand each of B and E held tog.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

kfb (knit in front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k through back of same st – 1 st increased.

NOTES:

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece with 2 strands of yarn held tog, then sewn together to make a loop.
- 2. All slip sts should be slipped as if to purl.

SCARF

With 1 strand each of B and E held tog, cast on 40 sts.

Knit 1 row.

Row 1 (RS): SI 1, kfb, k to last st, p1 - you will have 41 sts at the end of this row.

Row 2: Sl 1, k to last st, p1.

Rows 3-12: Rep Rows 1 and 2 five times - 46 sts.

Row 13: Sl 1, kfb, k to last st, p1 - 47 sts.

Row 14: Bind off 7 sts, k to last st, p1 - 40 sts.

Rows 15-28: Rep Rows 1-14, changing color as in following stripe sequence: Work first 2 rows with 1 strand each of C and F held tog, (2 rows with 1 strand each of B and E held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand each of C and F held tog) 3 times.

Rows 29-56: Rep Rows 1-28, changing color as in following stripe sequence: Work first 14 rows with 1 strand each of C and F held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand each of C and F held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand each of C and F held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand each of A and D held tog) 3 times.

Rows 57-84: Rep Rows 1-28, changing color as in following stripe sequence: Work first 14 rows with 1 strand each of A and D held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand each of B and E held tog, (2 rows with 1 strand each of A and D held tog, 2 rows with 1 strand each of B and E held tog) 3 times.

Rows 85-336: Rep Rows 1-84 three more times.

Bind off as if to knit.

FINISHING

Sew short ends tog to make a loop.

Weave in ends.
