### Miss Fisher's Cloche Hat

**SKILL LEVEL:** Intermediate (Level 3)

**SIZE:** One Size

**Finished Circumference** About 25 in. (63.5 cm), can be adjusted to fit a range of sizes

#### MATERIALS

- 496-200 [Lion Brand LB Collection Crepe Melange: Twig](#)  
2 Balls (A)
- 484-153 [Lion Brand LB Collection Silk Mohair Yarn: Midnight](#)  
1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 8 \[5 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Double-Pointed Needles - Size 7](#)
- [Lion Brand Cable Needles \(Set of 2\)](#)
- [Pom pom Maker](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

#### GAUGE:

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with larger needles and A.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

##### yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

#### NOTES:

1. Hat Band is worked first, then stitches for the body of the Hat are picked up along one long edge of Band.
2. Stitches are picked up along Band to make a rolled edge.

3. All stitches are picked up through the back loops to create an attractive 'ridge' on the Hat.
4. A knitted cord is worked separately, then woven through the cable on the Band. The cord allows you to adjust the fit of the Hat.

## **HAT**

### **Band**

With straight needles and A, cast on 12 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, p2, k2, yo, sl 2 sts to cable needle (cn) and hold at back of work, k2tog, k2 from cn, p2, k1.

**Rows 2-4:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts as they face you.

**Row 5:** K1, p2, sl 2 sts to cn and hold at front of work, k2, k2tog from cn, yo, k2, p2, k1.

**Rows 6-8:** K the knit sts and p the purl sts as they face you.

Rep Rows 1-8 until piece measures about 25 in. (63.5 cm) long, end with a Row 3 or 7 as the last row you work.

Bind off.

### **Rolled Edge**

From RS, with straight needles and A, and working through the back loops only, pick up and k 86 sts evenly spaced along one long side of Band. (**Note:** To make it easier to pick up evenly, first divide Band in halves, then into quarters. Now, simply pick up and k 22 sts across first quarter, 21 sts across 2nd quarter, 22 sts across 3rd quarter and 21 sts across last quarter.

) Beg with a WS (purl) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) for 8 rows.

Bind off.

### **Body of Hat**

From RS, with straight needles and A, and working through the back loops only, pick up and k 86 sts evenly spaced along opposite long side of Band.

Beg with a WS row, work in St st for 28 rows.

**Next Row:** K2tog across – you will have 43 sts at the end of this row.

**Next Row:** K1, k2tog across – 22 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread yarn tail through rem sts and pull to close top of Hat. Knot end, then sew sides of Hat together, including Band.

## **FINISHING**

### **Knitted Cord**

With B, and working with 2 double pointed needles, cast on 6 sts. Knit the 6 sts. Do not turn work. \*Slide sts to other end of needle and knit them, pulling yarn tightly across the back of the work, (do not turn work); rep from \* until cord measures about 34 in. (86.5 cm) long.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread yarn tail through rem sts and pull to gather. Knot securely.

Weave cord in and out of eyelets in cable on Band.

With B and following package directions, make 2 pom-poms.

Sew a pom-pom to each end of knitted cord.

Weave in ends.
