MATERIALS

- 866-139 Lion Brand Vanna's Complement: Berrylicious
3 Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Vanna's Complement (Article #866). 100% Acrylic;
package size: 3.00oz/85.00 gr. (185yds/170m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

11 1/2 dc and 6 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Cowl is worked in one piece in the rnd beg at lower edge.
2. If you find it difficult to join the beg ch into a ring without twisting the ch, Rnd 1 can be worked as a row then joined into a rnd, as follows: Leaving a long beg tail, ch 133, sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across join with sl st in first sc - you will have 132 sc at the end of this row/rnd. Use beg tail to sew gap at base of first row closed. Proceed to Rnd 2.

COWL

Ch 132.

Taking care not to twist ch, join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc in same ch as joining and each ch around join with sl st in first sc - you will have 132 sc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2: Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch-1 sp), turn, sk next st, dc in next st, * ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st rep from * to last st, ch 1, sk last st join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch - 66 dc and 66 ch-1 sps.

Rnds 3-5: Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch-1 sp), turn, sk first ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, * ch 1, sk next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc rep from * to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk last ch-1 sp join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch.

Rnd 6: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in each ch-1 sp and dc around join with sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnds 7-16: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in each st around join with sl st in top of beg ch - 132 dc.

Shape Shoulders and Neck

Rnd 17 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this rnd and all following rnds), turn, dc in next 9 sts, dc2tog, * dc in next 10 sts, dc2tog rep from * around join with sl st in top of beg ch - 121 dc.

Rnd 18: Rep Rnd 7.

Rnd 19 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 3, turn, * dc in next 10 sts, dc2tog rep from * around join with sl st in top of beg ch - 111 dc.

Rnd 20: Rep Rnd 7.

Rnd 21 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 3, turn, * dc in next 8 sts, dc2tog rep from * around join with sl st in top of beg ch - 100 dc.

Rnd 22: Rep Rnd 7.

Rnd 23 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 3, turn, dc in next 7 sts, dc2tog, * dc in next 8 sts, dc2tog rep from * around join with sl st in top of beg ch - 90 dc.

Rnd 24: Rep Rnd 7.

Rnd 25 (Decrease Rnd): Ch 3, turn, dc in next 6 sts, dc2tog, * dc in next 7 sts, dc2tog rep from * around join with sl st in top of beg ch - 80 dc.

Rnds 26-36: Rep Rnd 7 eleven times.

Rnds 37 and 38: Rep Rnds 2 and 3 - 40 dc and 40 ch-1 sps.

Rnd 39: Ch 1, turn, sc in each dc and ch-1 sp around join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
