12 sc = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

1. Hat is worked back and forth in one piece.
2. Completed piece is sewed together to make a tube, then one end of the tube is gathered to make the top of the Hat.

Leaving a long yarn tail, ch 61.

Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 60 sc at the end of this row.

Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures about 10 1/2 in. (26.5 cm) from beg.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread cast-on tail into blunt needle and sew side edges of piece together to make a tube.

Thread yarn tail from bound-off edge into blunt needle, then sew in and out through sts of last row. Pull to gather top of hat and knot securely.

Weave in ends.
