MATERIALS

• 826-206 <u>Lion Brand Scarfie:</u> Cream/Taupe

1 Ball

- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook</u> -Size J-10 (6 mm)
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u>
 <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>

*<u>Scarfie</u> (Article #826). 78% acrylic, 22% wool; package size: 5.30oz/150.00 gr. (312yds/285m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

Rows 1-3 = about 7 in. (18 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

Scarf is crocheted in one piece in an easy to work pattern!

SCARF

Ch 26.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *ch 3, sk next 3 ch, sc in next ch; rep from * across – you will have 7 sc and 6 ch-3 sps.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first sc, work 3 dc in each ch-3 sp across, dc in last sc – six 3 dc-groups and 1 dc at each end.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, ch 3, sk next 3 dc, *sc in sp between last dc and next dc, ch 3, sk next 3 dc; rep from * to last st, sc in top of beg ch – 7 sc and 6 ch-3 sps.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 until almost all yarn has been used, ending with a Row 3 as the last row you work. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
