Free Crochet Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand[®] Wool-Ease[®] Chunky Rail Fence Cowl

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SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 56 1/2 in. (143.5 cm)

Finished Height About 9 in. (23 cm)

CORRECTIONS: (applied Jun 20, 2016)

Row 2: With B, turn, *ch 10, turn, sk 10 sts, sc in next 10 sts; rep from * to end.

MATERIALS

 630-144 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Wool-Ease Chunky Yarn:</u> <u>Eggplant</u>

1 Ball (A)

 630-131 <u>Lion Brand</u> <u>Wool-Ease Chunky Yarn:</u> Moss

1 Ball (B)

<u>Lion Brand Crochet</u>
 <u>Hook - Size N-13 (9</u>
 mm)

<u>Lion Brand Large-Eye</u>
 Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*Wool-Ease Chunky (Article #630). **Solids:** 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool;

301 Tinsel White: 78% Acrylic, 19% Wool, 3% Other;

402 Wheat: 86% Acrylic, 10% Wool, 4% Other; package size: 5.00oz/140.00 gr. (153yds/140m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

 $8 \frac{1}{2} \text{ sts} + 6 \frac{1}{2} \text{ rows} = \text{about 4 in. (10 cm) in pattern.}$

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Piece is worked flat then seamed to make Cowl.
- 2. A larger hook was used for this design to create a more open stitch pattern.
- 3. To change color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete st. Carry color not in use along side edge of piece.

COWL

With A, ch 122.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch to end - 120 dc.

Change to B.

Row 2: With B, turn, *ch 10, sk 10 sts, sc in next 10 sts; rep from * to end.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, dc in next st and in each st and ch to end -120 dc.

Change to A.

Row 4: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in first 10 sts, *ch 10, sk 10 sts, sc in next 10 sts; rep from * to last 10 sts, ch 10, sc in top of beg ch.

Row 5: Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch and in each ch and st to end – 120 dc.

Change to B.

Rows 6-13: Rep Rows 2-5.

Rows 14 and 15: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

FINISHING

With yarn tail, sew short ends of piece together to make Cowl.

Weave in ends.
