SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Finished Circumference About 60 in. (152.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- 630-186 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Chunky Yarn: **Wool-Ease Chunky (Article #630). Solids: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool*
Amber
2 Balls
 - Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size N-13 (9 mm)
 - Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- 301 Tinsel White:** 78% Acrylic, 19% Wool, 3% Other*
- 402 Wheat:** 86% Acrylic, 10% Wool, 4% Other; package size: 5.00oz/140.00 gr. (153yds/140m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

9 sc + 9 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm)

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

CDC (Crossed Double Crochet) Skip next st, dc in following st, dc into skipped st working in front of previous dc.

NOTES:

1. Piece is worked flat in 3 different stitch patterns, then seamed to make Cowl.
2. A larger hook was used for this design to create more open stitch patterns.

COWL

Ch 21.

Pattern 1

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch to end – 20 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st and in each st across.

Rows 3-40: Rep Row 2.

Pattern 2

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as first dc in this row and in all following rows), turn, *CDC over next 2 sts; rep from * to last st, dc in last st – 9 dc.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn, dc in next st and in each st across – 20 dc.

Rows 3-22: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Pattern 3

Row 1 (RS): Ch 4 (counts as first tr in this row and in all following rows), turn, 2 tr in next st, sk 2 sts, tr in next st, *sk 2 sts, 5 tr in next st, sk 2 sts, tr in next st; rep from * to last 3 sts, sk 2 sts, 3 tr in last st.

Row 2: Ch 4, turn, *sk next 2 sts, 5 tr in next st, sk next 2 sts, tr in next st; rep from * across.

Row 3: Ch 4, turn, 2 tr in same st, sk 2 sts, tr in next st, * sk 2 sts, 5 tr in next st, sk 2 sts, tr in next st; rep from * to last 3 sts, sk 2 sts, 3 tr in last st.

Rows 4-15: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew short ends together to make Cowl.

Weave in ends.
