GAUGE:

1 Square = about 7 x 7 in. (18 x 18 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. 48 Squares are made separately then sewn together following a diagram.
- 2. Each Square is worked in rnds with 2 colors. One color is always A, the other color is either B, C, D, E, F, or G.
- 3. The color is changed when working a corner ch-3. To change yarn color at a corner, ch 2 with old color. Yarn over with new color and draw through loop on hook for ch 1. Proceed with new color. Do

not fasten off old color.

4. An edging is worked around the outside edge of the Afghan.



SQUARE (make 48 - 8 each with B, C, D, E, F, and G as solid color)

With solid color, ch 5; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Rnd 1 (RS): With solid color, ch 3 (counts as first dc), 2 dc in ring, ch 3, 3 dc in ring, ch 2; change to A, ch 1, (3 dc in ring, ch 3) twice; join with sl st in top of beg ch – you will have four 3-dc groups (2 groups worked with A and 2 groups worked with solid color) and 4 corner ch-3 sps at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2 (WS): With A, turn, sl st in first 2 ch of first ch-3 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to next corner ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in corner ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to next corner ch-3 sp, 2 dc in corner ch-3 sp, ch 2; change to solid color, ch 1, 3 dc in same corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in next corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in first ch-3 sp, ch 3; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Four 3-dc groups worked with solid color, 14 dc worked with A (7 dc across each of 2 sides) and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

Rnd 3: With solid color, turn, sl st in first 2 ch of first ch-3 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in corner ch-3 sp, ch 2; change to A, ch 1, 2 dc in same corner ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to next corner ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in corner ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to first ch-3 sp, 2 dc in first ch-3 sp, ch 3; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Six 3-dc groups worked with solid color, 22 dc worked with A (11 dc across each of 2 sides) and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

Rnd 4: With A, turn, sl st in first 2 ch of first ch-3 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to next corner ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in corner ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to next corner ch-3 sp, 2 dc in corner ch-3 sp, ch 2; change to solid color, ch 1, 3 dc in same corner ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) twice, ch 1, 3 dc in first ch-3 sp, ch 3; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Eight 3-dc groups worked with solid color, 30 dc worked with A (15 dc across each of 2 sides) and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

Rnd 5: With solid color, turn, sl st in first 2 ch of first ch-3 sp, ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times ch 1, (3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc) in corner ch-3 sp, (ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, 3 dc in corner ch-3 sp, ch 2; change to A, ch 1, 2 dc in same corner ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to next corner ch-3 sp, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in corner ch-3 sp, dc in each dc to first ch-3 sp, 2 dc in first ch-3 sp, ch 3; join with sl st in top of beg ch – Ten 3-dc groups worked with solid color, 38 dc worked with A (19 dc across each of 2 sides) and 4 corner ch-3 sps.

Fasten off.

BLOCK I (make 4)


Following diagram, sew 2 A/B Squares and 2 A/C Squares together to make Block I.

BLOCK II (make 4)

Following diagram, sew 2 A/D Squares and 2 A/E Squares together to make Block II.


BLOCK III (make 4)

Following diagram, sew 2 A/F Squares and 2 A/G Squares together to make Block III.



FINISHING

Following diagram, sew blocks into 3 strips of 4 blocks each, then sew strips together to make Afghan.



Edging

From RS, join A with a sl st anywhere along outside edge of Afghan.

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work sc evenly spaced around outside edge of Afghan, working 4 sc in ch-sp at each corner of Afghan; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2 (WS): Turn, working in front loops only, sl st in each st around; join with sl st in first st.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
