792-410 <u>Lion Brand Homespun</u>
 <u>Thick & Quick Yarn: Herb Garden</u>
 2 Balls (A)

 792-381 <u>Lion Brand Homespun</u> <u>Thick & Quick Yarn: Barley</u>

 1 Ball (B)

- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size P-15 (10 mm)</u>
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>

*Homespun Thick & Quick (Article #792). 88% Acrylic, 12% Polyester; package size: 8.00oz/227.00 gr. (160yds/146m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

6 dc = about 4 in. (10 cm)

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Shawl is worked in 3 sections. The second and third sections are worked directly onto the first section.
- 2. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops to complete the st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

SHAWL

First Section

With A, ch 62.

Row 1 (RS): Do in 4th ch from hook (beg 3 ch count as first dc) and in each ch across – you will have 60 dc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in next sc and in each sc across. Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 20 in. (51 cm) from beg. Fasten off.

Second Section

From RS, join B with a sl st to beg of Row 1, ready to work across the short end of First Section.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as first dc), work 29 dc evenly spaced across – 30 dc.

Rep Rows 2 and 3 of first section until second section measures about 8 in. (20.5 cm), changing to A in the last st. With A, continue to rep Rows 2 and 3 until second section measures about 10 in. (25.5 cm). Fasten off.

Third Section

Work as for second section, working along opposite end of first section.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
