Finished Circumference About 18 in. (45.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes

MATERIALS

- 861-170 [Lion Brand Vanna's Glamour Yarn: Topaz](#)
1 Ball

- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 5 \[3.75 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

**Vanna's Glamour (Article #861). 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/49.61 gr. (202yds/185m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

22 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Purl st (purl every row).

When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

1. The Headband is worked as a rectangle in Purl st (purl every row) and then seamed.
2. The Wrap is a smaller rectangle worked in St st (k on RS, p on WS), that is folded and seamed around the Headband.

HEADBAND

Cast on 24 sts.

Work in Purl st (purl every row) until piece measures about 18 in. (45.5 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

Cut yarn, leaving a 12 in. (30.5 cm) long yarn tail.

WRAP

Cast on 12 sts.

Work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 4 in. (10 cm) from beg.

Bind off.

Cut yarn leaving a 6 in. (15 cm) long yarn tail.

FINISHING

With yarn tail, sew ends of Headband together to make a ring.

Fold Wrap around Headband, bringing cast on end to meet bound off end and covering the Headband seam.

With yarn tail, sew ends of Wrap together, then take a few sts through the Wrap to secure it in place on the Headband. Weave in ends.
