Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick® Quick Knit Capelet

Pattern Number: L40623

SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: XS/S, M/L, 1X/2X

Finished Width at Bottom About 51 (55, 60) in. (129.5 (139.5, 152.5) cm)

Finished Length About 16 (17, 18) in. (40.5 (43, 45.5) cm), not including collar

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

MATERIALS

- 640-154 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Grey Marble
4 5, 6 Balls
 - Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
 - Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
 - Additional Materials
Circular knitting needle size 13 (9 mm), 36 in. (91.5 cm) long
3 buttons, 1 1/2 in. (38 mm) diameter
- *Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640).
Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool
Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon
Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon
Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m)
Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m)
Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



GAUGE:

9 sts + 12 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Stockinette st (knit on RS, purl on WS).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

yo (yarn over)

An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

kfb (knit into front and back) Knit next st without removing it from left needle, then k

through back of same st –1 st increased.

NOTES:

Capelet is worked in one piece beginning at bottom edge.

CAPELET

Cast on 126 (138, 150) sts.

Knit 6 rows.

Row 1 (WS): K4, place marker (pm), p2, *k2, p2; rep from * to last 4 sts, pm, k4.

Row 2 (RS): Knit.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 9 (10, 11) in. (23 (25.5, 28) cm) from beg, ending with a Row 1 as the last row you work.

Buttonhole Row (RS): K2, k2tog, yo (for buttonhole), k to end.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until piece measures about 10 (11, 12) in. (25.5 (28, 30.5) cm) from beg, ending with a Row 1 as the last row you work.

Decrease Row (RS): K6, *k1, k2tog, k1; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 97 (106, 115) sts.

Next Row (WS): K4, *p2, k1; rep from * to last 6 sts, p2, k4.

Next Row: Knit.

Rep last 2 rows until piece measures about 12 (13, 14) in. (30.5 (33, 35.5) cm) ending with a WS row as the last row you work.

Rep Buttonhole Row.

Continue in pattern as established until piece measures about 13 (14, 15) in. (33 (35.5, 38) cm) from beg, ending with a WS row as the last row you work.

Decrease Row (RS): K6, *k2tog, k1; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 68 (74, 80) sts.

Next Row (WS): K4, p to last 4 sts, k4.

Next Row (RS): Knit.

Rep last two rows until piece measures about 15 (16, 17) in. (38 (40.5, 43) cm) from beg, ending with a WS row as the last row you work.

Rep Buttonhole Row.

Continue in pattern as established until piece measures about 16 (17, 18) in. (40.5 (43, 45.5) cm) from beg, ending with a WS row as the last row you work.

Decrease Row (RS): K4, *k1, k2tog; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 – 48 (52, 56) sts.

Collar

Knit 4 rows.

Next Row: Kfb, knit to end of row – 49 (53, 57) sts.

Rep last row until you have 68 (72, 76) sts.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew buttons to left front opposite buttonholes.

Weave in ends.
