- Solid, Heather, Twist: 80% acrylic, 20% wool
- Sprinkles, Wheat, Mushroom, Rainbow Mist: 86% acrylic, 10% wool, 4% rayon
- Glitter/Multi-colors: 78% acrylic, 19% wool, 3% polyester
- Frosts: 70% acrylic, 20% wool, 10% polyamide
- Prints: 80% acrylic, 20% wool

GAUGE:

18 sts + 24 rows = 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with A.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Wrap is worked in St st (k on RS, p on WS) with Garter st (k every row) borders.
- 2. One buttonhole is worked on Wrap and a button is sewn to opposite side.
- 3. Simple embroidery is worked onto completed Wrap.

WRAP

With A, cast on 54 sts.

Work in Garter st (k every row) for 10 rows for beginning border.

Next Row (RS): Knit.

Next Row (WS): K5, p to last 5 sts, k5.

Continue as established, working first and last 5 sts in Garter st for borders, remaining sts in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 11 in. (28 cm) from beg, end with a WS row as the last row you work.

Buttonhole

Next Row (RS): K2, bind off next 3 sts, k to end of row. **Next Row:** K5, p to last 2 sts, cast on 3 sts, k2. Continue as established, working first and last 5 sts in Garter st for borders, remaining sts in St st, until piece measures about 56 1/2 in. (143.5 cm) from beg.

Work in Garter st for 10 rows for ending border. Bind off.

FINISHING

Embroidery


Note: Embroidery is meant to have a rustic look. You needn't measure the spacing for the embroidered lines, ours were randomly spaced.

Cut a 2 yd. (2 m) length of B and thread into blunt needle. Knot one end of strand about 1 in. (2.5 cm) from end. From RS, pull strand through St st portion of Wrap, just above lower border and just inside the side Garter st border. Knotted end of strand will be on RS of Wrap. Embroider straight sts along the length of the Wrap, ending just inside the top border. Knot strand and trim, leaving a 1 in. (2.5 cm) yarn end.

Rep to make about 11 parallel lines of straight sts vertically across Wrap.

Rep to make about 33 horizontal lines of straight sts, cutting an 18 in. (45.5 cm) strand of B for each line.

With sewing needle and thread, sew button to Wrap opposite buttonhole.
