*Martha Stewart CraftsTM/MC Extra Soft Wool Blend (Article #5400). 65% Acrylic, 35% Wool; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (165yds/150m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

13 sts + 26 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter Stitch (knit one row, purl one row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Follow loom manual instructions for SINGLE KNITTING for how to cast on, knit, purl, and bind off.
- 2. Two Squares are worked, then sewn together to make Hat.
- 3. Both Squares are worked with 2 strands of yarn held together. The 2 strands are both the same color, so you'll need to wind yarns A and B each into 2 separate balls before beginning.
- 4. Each Square is worked in a separate stripe pattern.
- 5. To change color, work to last stitch with old color, work last st with old and new color held together. Drop old color to back of loom and continue with new color.

Use the following pieces: (2) 36-hole pieces, (2) 28-hole semi-circular pieces.

Connect pieces to form an oval as follows: 36-hole piece > 28-hole semi-circular piece > 36-hole piece > 28-hole semi-circular piece.

Lay loom onto a flat surface, with one long side of the oval shape horizontally in front of you.

Insert 28 large pink pegs into every other hole across the front and sides of the loom – 28 working pegs placed.

Insert a contrast color peg (for slip knot) to the right of first peg you placed.

Insert a grey peg into each connecting hole along the back side of the loom to hold the loom pieces together.

SQUARE 1

With 2 strands of A held together, cast onto the 28 working pegs.

Rows 1, 3 and 5: Knit. Rows 2 and 4: Purl.

Row 6: Purl, changing to 2 strands of B in the last stitch.

Rows 7 and 9: With B, knit.

Row 8: With B, purl.

Row 10: Purl, changing to 2 strands of A in last stitch.

Rows 11 and 13: With A, knit.

Row 12: With A, purl.

Row 14: With A, purl, changing to 2 strands of B in last stitch.

Repeat Rows 7-14 until piece measures about 9 1/2 in. (24 cm) from cast on edge.

Bind off.

SQUARE 2

With 2 strands of B held together cast onto the 28 working pegs.

Rows 1 and 3: Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 4: Purl, changing to 2 strands of A in last stitch.

Row 5: With A, knit.

Row 6: With A, purl, changing to 2 strands of B in last stitch.

Row 7: With B, knit.

Row 8: With B, purl, changing to 2 strands of A in last stitch.

Rep Rows 5-8 until piece measures about 9 in. (23 cm) ending with a purl row as the last row you work. Continuing with the same color, knit one row then purl one row.


Bind off.

FINISHING

Following diagram, sew cast on and bound off edges of Square 2 to side edges of Square 1.

Thread a length of either color yarn into yarn needle provided with loom and weave in and out of one edge of Hat. Pull yarn to gather top of Hat, then knot.

Thread yarn ends into yarn needle and weave into the fabric of the Hat.
