## **SKILL LEVEL:** <u>Easy + (Level 3)</u>

SIZE: One Size

#### MATERIALS

- 545-201 Lion Brand Landscapes: Boardwalk 1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size J-10 (6 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



#### GAUGE:

4 V-sts + 7 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

# STITCH EXPLANATION:

**V-st** (Dc, ch 1, dc) all in same indicated st or sp.

#### NOTES:

1. Shawl is worked back and forth in rows beg at lower point. We've included a stitch diagram to help you with the pattern stitch.

2. Edging is worked around outside edge of Shawl.



#### SHAWL

Ch 6.

**Row 1:** V-st in 5th ch from hook, dc in last ch – you will have 1 beg ch-sp, 1 V-st, and 1 dc at the end of this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 6, turn, V-st in 5th ch from hook, sk next V-st, (sl st, ch 3, V-st, dc) in beg ch-sp – 2 V-sts.

**Row 3:** Ch 6, turn, V-st in 5th ch from hook, sk next V-st, (sl st, ch 3, V-st) in next ch-3 sp, sk next V-st, (sl st, ch 3, V-st, dc) in beg ch-sp – 3 V-sts.

**Row 4:** Ch 6, turn, V-st in 5th ch from hook, \*sk next V-st, (sl st, ch 3, V-st) in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* once more, sk last V-st, (sl st, ch 3, V-st, dc) in beg ch-sp – 4 V-sts.

**Rows 5-21:** Ch 6, turn, V-st in 5th ch from hook, \*sk next V-st, (sl st, ch 3, V-st) in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* to last V-st, sk last V-st, (sl st, ch 3, V-st, dc) in beg ch-sp – 21 V-sts at the end of Row 21. Do NOT fasten off.

**Edging Rnd:** Ch 3, turn, sk first V-st, sc in next ch-3 sp, \*ch 1, dc in next sl st, ch 1, sc in next ch-3 sp; rep from \* across working last sc in beg ch-sp, ch 1, sc in same beg ch-sp; working in ends of rows across diagonal side edges, (sc, ch 3, sc) in ch at base of first V-st, ch 1, sc around dc at end of next row, \*\*ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) in ch at base of next V-st, ch 1, sc around dc at end of next row, irrep from \*\* down first side edge, around lower point, and up opposite side edge, ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) in beg ch-3 sp of this rnd, ch 1; join with sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
