LEVEL 2-EASY CROCHET PULLOVER

LION BRAND® LION'S PRIDE® WOOLSPUN®

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® LION'S PRIDE® WOOLSPUN® (Art. #671)
 #110 Navy Heather 7 (9) balls (A)
 #503 Sea Mist Mix 2 (3) balls (B)
 or colors of your choice
- LION BRAND® crochet hook size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



SIZES

S-L (1-2X)

Finished Bust About 60 (68) in. (152.5 (172.5) cm) Finished Length About 26 (28) in. (66 (71) cm) Note: Pattern is written for smaller size with changes for larger size in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to both sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

GAUGE

11 dc + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.


NOTES

- 1. Pullover is made in 4 pieces Front, Back and 2 Sleeves.
- 2. Front and Back are worked from side to side. Sleeves are worked from wrist edge up.

STEP 1

BACK

With A, chain 73 (79).



STEP 2


Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (the 3 skipped ch count as the first dc) and in each ch across – 71 (77) sts.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch-1 sp), turn, sk first 2 sts, dc in next st, *ch 1, sk next st, dc in next st; repeat from * across working last dc in top of beg ch - you now have 36 (39) dc and 35 (38) ch-1 sps.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in first ch-1 sp, *dc in next dc, dc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * across, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch - 71 (77) dc.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until piece measures about 30 (34) in. (76 (86.5) cm) from beg, ending with a Row 3 as the last row you work.

Fasten off.



STEP 3

Edging

Join B with a sl st in corner so that you can work along one long edge of piece (this edge measures 30 (34) in. (76 (86.5) cm).

Ch 1, then work sc evenly spaced along this edge, this is now the top edge.

Fasten off.



FRONT

Make same as Back.

STEP 4

SLEEVES (make 2)

With B, chain 28 (34).

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (the 3 skipped ch count as the first dc) and in each ch across - 26 (32) sts.

Rows 2-4: Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, sk first st, dc in next st and in each st across working last dc in top of beg ch.

Row 5 (Increase Row): Ch 3 (counts as first dc), turn, dc in first st, dc in each st to beg ch, 2 dc in top of beg ch - 28 (34) dc.


Rows 6-13 (17): Repeat Rows 2-5 for 2 (3) more times – 32 (40) dc.

Row 14 (18): Repeat Row 2.

Row 15 (19): Repeat Row 5 (Increase Row) – 34 (42) dc.

Row 16 (20): Repeat Row 2.

Fasten off.



Sew top edges of Back and Front together for shoulders. Leave neck open. Sew on Sleeves.

Sew side and Sleeve seams.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
