MATERIALS NOTE

Materials are sufficient to make multiple Toys.

*<u>Vanna's Choice</u>® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic

400, 401, 403: 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon **402:** 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m)

Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers: 3 ozs (85

g) , 145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111

meters)



GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

- 1. Buns, Hamburger and garnishes are worked separately, then sewn together.
- 2. All pieces are worked in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.
- 3. We used a smaller hook than usual for this yarn to create a dense fabric for this toy.

TOP BUN

With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch; place marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – you will have 12 sc at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 3: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 5: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnd 7: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around – 42 sc.

Rnd 8: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * around – 48 sc.

Rnds 9-13: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 14: Working through back loops only, *sc2tog, sc in each of next 6 sts; rep from * around – 42 sc.

Rnd 15: *Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnd 16: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 17: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Begin stuffing piece firmly.

Rnd 18: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 19: *Sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Finish stuffing piece.

Rnd 20: Sc2tog around – 6 sc.

Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and weave through last rnd. Pull gently to draw sts together and knot.

BOTTOM BUN

With A, ch 2.

Rnds 1-8: Rep Rnds 1-8 of Top Bun – 48 sc.

Rnds 9-11: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 12: *Sc2tog, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * around – 42 sc.

Rnd 13: *Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around – 36 sc.

Rnd 14: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 15: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Begin stuffing piece firmly.

Rnd 16: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 17: *Sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from * around – 12 sc.

Finish stuffing piece.

Rnd 18: Sc2tog around – 6 sc.

Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and weave through last rnd. Pull gently to draw sts together and knot.

HAMBURGER

With B, ch 2.

Rnds 1-18: Rep Rnds 1-18 of Bottom Bun.

Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and weave through last

rnd. Pull gently to draw sts together and knot.

LETTUCE

With C, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch; place marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – 12 sc.

Rnd 3: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 24 sc.

Rnd 5: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around – 45 sc.

Rnd 7: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around – 60 sc.

Rnd 8: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around - 75 sc.

Rnd 9: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around – 90 sc.

Fasten off.

TOMATOES (make 2)

With E, ch 2.

Rnds 1-5: Rep Rnds 1-5 of Top Bun.

Fasten off.

CHEESE

With D, ch 17.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 16 sc.

Rows 2-17: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Sew Hamburger onto Bottom Bun. Sew Lettuce and Tomatoes onto Hamburger then sew on Top Bun.
