## MATERI ALS NOTE

Materials are sufficient to make multiple Toys.

## GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.
sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook - 1 st decreased.

## NOTES:

1. Buns, Hamburger and garnishes are worked separately, then sewn together.
2. All pieces are worked in continuous rnds; do not join or turn unless otherwise instructed.
3. We used a smaller hook than usual for this yarn to create a dense fabric for this toy.

## TOP BUN

## With A, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch; place marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.
Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around - you will have 12 sc at the end of this rnd.
Rnd 3: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around - 18 sc.
Rnd 4: Work $* 2$ sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from $*$ around -24 sc .
Rnd 5: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around - 30 sc .
Rnd 6: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from $*$ around -36 sc .
Rnd 7: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around - 42 sc .
Rnd 8: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * around - 48 sc .
Rnds 9-13: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 14: Working through back loops only, *sc2tog, sc in each of next 6 sts; rep from * around - 42 sc.
Rnd 15: *Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around - 36 sc .
Rnd 16: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around - 30 sc.
Rnd 17: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around - 24 sc.
Begin stuffing piece firmly.
Rnd 18: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around - 18 sc.
Rnd 19: *Sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from * around - 12 sc.
Finish stuffing piece.
Rnd 20: Sc2tog around - 6 sc.
Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and weave through last rnd. Pull gently to draw sts together and knot.

## BOTTOM BUN

With A, ch 2.
Rnds 1-8: Rep Rnds 1-8 of Top Bun - 48 sc.
Rnds 9-11: Sc in each st around.
Rnd 12: *Sc2tog, sc in next 6 sts; rep from * around - 42 sc.
Rnd 13: *Sc2tog, sc in next 5 sts; rep from * around - 36 sc.
Rnd 14: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around - 30 sc.
Rnd 15: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around - 24 sc.
Begin stuffing piece firmly.
Rnd 16: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around - 18 sc.
Rnd 17: *Sc2tog, sc in next st; rep from * around - 12 sc.
Finish stuffing piece.
Rnd 18: Sc2tog around - 6 sc .
Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and weave through last rnd. Pull gently to draw sts together and knot.

## HAMBURGER

With B, ch 2.
Rnds 1-18: Rep Rnds 1-18 of Bottom Bun.
Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle and weave through last
rnd. Pull gently to draw sts together and knot.

## LETTUCE

With C, ch 2.
Rnd 1: Work 6 sc in first ch; place marker to indicate beg of rnd; move marker up as each rnd is completed.
Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around - 12 sc .
Rnd 3: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around - 18 sc .
Rnd 4: Work $* 2$ sc in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around -24 sc .
Rnd 5: Work *2 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around - 30 sc.
Rnd 6: Work $* 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, sc in next st; rep from * around - 45 sc .
Rnd 7: Work ${ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, sc in next 2 sts; rep from * around -60 sc .
Rnd 8: Work $* 2$ sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts; rep from * around - 75 sc .
Rnd 9: Work * 2 sc in next st, sc in next 4 sts; rep from * around - 90 sc.
Fasten off.

## TOMATOES (make 2)

With E , ch 2.
Rnds 1-5: Rep Rnds 1-5 of Top Bun.
Fasten off.

## CHEESE

With D , ch 17.
Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across - 16 sc .
Rows 2-17: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.
Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
Sew Hamburger onto Bottom Bun. Sew Lettuce and Tomatoes onto Hamburger then sew on Top Bun.
