**MATERIALS** 

• 923-200 Lion Brand Ice Cream: Cookies & Cream

4 Balls

 Boye Aluminum Circular Knitting Needles 29 inches Size 5

- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Cable Needles (Set of 2)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



#### **GAUGE:**

26 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-10.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

#### **PATTERN STITCH**

Seed St (multiple of 2 sts + 1)

**Row 1:** \*K1, p1; rep from \* to last st, k1. **Row 2:** K the purl sts and p the knit sts.

Rep Row 2 for Seed st.

## CABLE PANEL (worked over 20 sts)

**Row 1 (RS):** P2, k2, p2, k8, p2, k2, p2.

Row 2 and all WS Rows: K the knit sts and p the purl sts.

Rows 3, 7 and 9: Rep Row 1.

Row 5: P2, k2, p2; slip next 4 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, k4, then k4 from cable needle; p2, k2, p2.

**Row 10:** Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-10 for Cable Panel.

### **NOTES:**

- 1. Blanket is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows on a circular needle, in alternating Cable Panels and Seed st panels.
- 2. Circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts, work back and forth in rows on circular



## **BLANKET**

Cast on 196 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** \*(K1 p1) 3 times, k1, place marker (pm), work Row 1 of Cable Panel over next 20 sts, pm; rep from \* to last 7 sts, (k1, p1) 3 times, k1.

**Row 2:** \*Work in Seed st to marker, slip marker (sm), work next row of Cable Panel over next 20 sts, sm; rep from \* to last marker, work in Seed st to end of row.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 40 in. (101.5 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 8 of the Cable Panel as the last row you work.

Bind off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.
