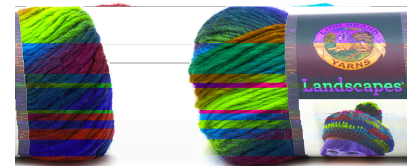

MATERIALS

- 545-203 Lion Brand Landscapes: Sand Dune
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Double-Pointed Needles - Size 10
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Pom pom Maker
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
3 1/2 x 5 in. (9x 12.5 cm) piece of cardboard

**Landscapes (Article #545). 100% acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (147yds/134m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

15 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Stockinette st (k every rnd) worked in rnds.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Hat is worked in one piece in the round on double pointed needles.
2. Stitches are decreased to shape the crown (top of Hat).

HAT

Note: For this Hat, you'll work with just 4 of the double-pointed needles – this keeps an even number of sts on each of the needles.

With double pointed needles, cast on 72 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles, placing 24 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Rnds 1-5: Work in St st (k every rnd).

Rnds 6 and 7: *P2, k2; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 8 and 9: *P1, k2, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 10 and 11: *K2, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 12 and 13: *K1, p2, k1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep Rnds 6-13 until piece measures about 6 in. (15 cm) from beg.

Shape Crown (Top of Hat)

Rnd 1 (Decrease Rnd): *K10, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – you will have 66 sts at the end of this rnd.

Rnd 2: Knit.

Rnd 3 (Decrease Rnd): *K9, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – 60 sts.

Rnd 4: Knit.

Rnd 5 (Decrease Rnd): *K8, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – 54 sts.

Rnd 6: Knit.

Rnd 7 (Decrease Rnd): *K7, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – 48 sts.

Rnd 8: Knit.

Rnd 9 (Decrease Rnd): *K6, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – 42 sts.

Rnd 10: Knit.

Rnd 11 (Decrease Rnd): *K5, k2tog; rep from * to end of rnd – 36 sts.

Rnd 12: Knit.

Rnd 13: K2tog around – 18 sts.

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through remaining sts. Pull tail to close opening at top of Hat. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Pom-Pom

Following package directions, make a small pom-pom. Tie center of pom-pom with 2 strands about 18 in. (45.5 cm) long, leaving 4 tails about 9 in. (23 cm) long. Trim one of the tails and braid rem 3 tails for about 3 in. (7.5 cm). Knot the ends tog to end the braid.

Tassel

Wrap yarn around 3 1/2 in. (9 cm) cardboard 40 times. Cut a 30 in. (76 cm) length of yarn and thread into large-eyed blunt needle, bringing ends tog to work with a doubled strand. Slide needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Knot securely around strands, leaving 4 tails about 10 in. (25.5 cm) long. Trim one of the tails and braid rem 3 tails for about 5 in. (12.5 cm). Knot the ends tog to end the braid. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard. Cut a 10 in. (25.5 cm) length of yarn and wrap tightly around loops 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) below top knot to form Tassel neck. Knot securely; thread yarn ends into needle and weave ends into center of Tassel. Trim Tassel ends evenly. Tie ends of braids on pom-pom and tassel to top of Hat. Weave in ends.
