*Modern Baby (Article #924). 50% Acrylic, 50% Nylon; package size: 2.60oz/75.00 gr. (173yds/158m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

20 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-20 of Stripe I.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

- 1. Afghan is worked in one piece in alternating sections of easy knit and purl sts.
- 2. The yarn color is changed to make stripes of varying widths.
- 3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle, just as if working on straight needles.



AFGHAN

With A, cast on 150 sts.

Stripe I

Rows 1-8: Knit. Row 9 (RS): Knit. Row 10: Purl.

Rows 11 and 12: Knit.

Rows 13-20: Rep Rows 9-12 twice.

Row 21: Knit. Row 22: Purl.

Stripe II

Change to B.

Rows 1 and 2: With B, knit. Rows 3 and 4: With C, knit.

Rows 5-16: Rep Rows 1-4 three times. Rows 17 and 18: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Change to D.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Rows 3 and 4: Knit. Rows 5-8: Rep Rows 1-4.

Row 9 and 10: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Stripe IV

Change to B.

Rows 1-12: Knit.

Stripe V

Change to E.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Rows 3 and 4: Knit.

Rows 5-16: Rep Rows 1-4 three times. Rows 17 and 18: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Stripe VI

Change to F.

Rows 1-3: Knit. Row 4: Purl.

ROW 4: Pull.

Rows 5-20: Rep Rows 1-4 four times.

Rep Stripes II, III, and IV.

Stripe VII

Change to G.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Rows 3 and 4: Knit.

Rows 5-20: Rep Rows 1-4 four times.

Stripe VIII

Change to B.

Rows 1 and 2: With B, knit. Rows 3 and 4: With C, knit.

Rows 5 and 6: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Stripe IX

Change to A.

Rows 1-3: Knit.

Row 4: Purl.

Rows 5-20: Rep Rows 1-4 four times.

Rep Stripes IV, III, and II.

Rep Stripes V and VI.

Rep Stripes IV, III, and II.

Stripe X

Change to G.

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Rows 3 and 4: Knit.

Rows 5-16: Rep Rows 1-4 three times.

Rows 17-22: Knit.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
