# Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn

## Lion Brand® Landscapes®

### Hip Slouch Hat

Pattern Number: L40743

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** Medium, Large

**Finished Circumference** About 17 1/2 (20 1/2) in. (44.5 (52) cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes.

**Finished Height** About 12 in. (30.5 cm)

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

#### MATERIALS

- 545-173 Lion Brand Landscapes:

Sage

1 Ball

- Boye Aluminum Circular Knitting Needles 16 inches Size 9
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Landscapes (Article #545). 100% acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (147yds/134m) pull skeins*



#### GAUGE:

16 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

Hat is worked in one piece in the round.

#### HAT

Cast on 70 (82) sts.

Place marker for beg of rnd and join by knitting the first st on the left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle and being careful not to twist.

Work in St st worked in the rnd (k every rnd) until piece measures about 12 1/2 in. (32 cm) from beg.

**Next Rnd:** Knit 2 together around – you will now have 35 (41) sts.

Knit one rnd, then cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then thread through sts of last rnd. Pull to gather top of Hat and knot securely.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
