

# Free Knitting Pattern LION BRAND® LION'S PRIDE® WOOLSPUN® LEVEL 2 - EASY KNIT SCARF & HAT

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#### **SKILL LEVEL** – EASY

#### **SIZES**

#### **SCARF**

About  $5^{1/2}$  x 56 in. (14 x 142 cm)

#### HAT

Finished Circumference About 18 in. (45.5 cm), will stretch to fit a range of sizes. Finished Height About 9 in. (23 cm)

#### **MATERIALS**

LION BRAND® LION'S PRIDE® WOOLSPUN® (Art. #671)

#204 Metropolis Print 1 ball (A)

#098 Fisherman 1 ball (B)

#504 City Lights Mix 1 ball (C)

#153 Black 1 ball (D)

or colors of your choice

- LION BRAND® knitting needles size 10.5 (6.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



## **GAUGE**

13 stitches + 19 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Stockinette stitch (knit on the right side and purl on the wrong side).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

## **NOTES**

- 1. Scarf is worked in a simple rib pattern, changing yarn color to make stripes.
- 2. Hat is worked in one piece, changing yarn color to make stripes, then seamed.
- 3. To change yarn color, just drop the old color then pick up the new color and start working with it, leaving a long yarn tail for weaving in later.

## STEP 1

#### **SCARF**

With A, cast on 27 stitches.




## STEP 2

**Row 1:** Knit 1, \*purl 1, knit 1; repeat from \* across.

Row 2: Knit the knit stitches and purl the purl stitches as they face you.


Rows 3-35: Repeat Row 2.



## STEP 3

Change to B and repeat Row 2 for 36 rows.
Change to C and repeat Row 2 for 36 rows.
Change to D and repeat Row 2 for 36 rows.
Change to A and repeat Row 2 for 36 rows.
Change to B and repeat Row 2 for 36 rows.
Change to C and repeat Row 2 for 35 rows.
Bind off.

Weave in yarn ends.



## STEP 4

#### HAT

With D, cast on 58 stitches.



## STEP 5

Row 1: \*Knit 1, purl 1; repeat from \* across.

Row 2: Knit the knit stitches and purl the purl stitches as they face you.


Rows 3-7: Repeat Row 2.



## STEP 6

Change to A and knit one row.

Continue in Stockinette stitch (knit on the right side and purl on the wrong side), working 5 more rows with A, then 2 rows with D, 8 rows with B, 8 rows with C and 16 rows with D.



# STEP 7

**Next Row:** With D, \*knit 2 stitches together; repeat from \* across row - you will now have 29 stitches. With D, purl one row.




## STEP 8

Cut yarn, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread yarn tail into blunt needle, then draw through remaining 29 stitches. Pull tightly to gather and knot securely.

Sew sides of piece together to make Hat.

Weave in yarn ends.
