### Shaded Fur Scarf

- 321-202 Lion Brand

Pelt: Mink

1 Ball (A)

- 321-203 Lion Brand

Pelt: Fisher

1 Ball (B)

- 321-205 Lion Brand

Pelt: Sable

1 Ball (C)

- 321-200 Lion Brand

Pelt: Red Fox

1 Ball (D)

- 321-204 Lion Brand

Pelt: Chinchilla

1 Ball (E)

- 321-201 Lion Brand

Pelt: Blue Mink

1 Ball (F)

- Lion Brand Knitting

Needles Size 11 [8

mm]

- Lion Brand Large-Eye

Blunt Needles (Set of

6)

*\*Pelt (Article #321). 68% Nylon, 32% Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (47yds/43m) pull skeins*



#### **GAUGE:**

14 sts + 17 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (knit every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

## SCARF

With A, cast on 24 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every row) for about 10 in. (25.5 cm). Continue working in Garter st, working about 10 in. (25.5 cm) each with B, C, D, E and F.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
