


Free Knitting Pattern Lion Brand® Vanna's Complement® Taconic Shrug Pattern Number: L50160

Free Knitting Pattern from Lion Brand Yarn Lion Brand® Vanna's Complement® Taconic Shrug

Pattern Number: L50160

SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 42 x 38 in. (106.5 x 96.5 cm), before folding and seaming

MATERIALS

- 866-145 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's</u> <u>Complement: Eqqplant</u>
 5 Balls
- Boye Aluminum Circular Knitting Needles 36 inches Size 10.5
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles</u> (Set of 6)

*Vanna's Complement (Article #866). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.00oz/85.00 gr. (185yds/170m) pull skeins



GAUGE:

12 sts + 24 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Lace pattern.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

yo (yarn over - between p2tog sts)


An increase that also creates a small decorative hole (eyelet) in the fabric, worked as follows:

- 1. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st.
- 2. Bring yarn to front, between the needles. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed. **Note:** If the next st is a knit st, do not bring yarn to front, between needles.

NOTES:

- 1. Shrug is worked in one piece in an easy Lace pattern with Garter st (k every row) borders.
- 2. Finished Shrug is folded and seamed to form sleeves.
- 3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
- 4. We used a larger needle than specified on yarn label to create a Shrug that drapes in a flattering way.





SHRUG

Cast on 126 sts.

Lower Border

Work in Garter st (k every row) for 2 rows.

Lace Pattern

Rows 1-3: Knit.

Row 4 (WS): K4 for border, *p2tog, yo; rep from * to last 4 sts, k4 for border.

Rows 5-7: Knit.

Row 8: K4, purl to last 4 sts, k4.

Rep Rows 1-8 for Lace pattern, until piece measures about 38 in. (96.5 cm) from beginning, end with a Row 7 as the last row you work.

Top Border

Work in Garter st for 2 rows.

Bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Following diagram, fold piece in half to measure 21×38 in. (53.5 x 96.5 cm). Place markers on each of the 21 in. (53.5 cm) sides, 7 in. (18 cm) below fold for armholes. Sew sides from markers down to lower edge.

Weave in ends.
