MATERIALS

- 135-098 [Lion Brand Hometown USA Yarn: Houston Cream](#)
18 Balls
- [Lion Brand Size 35 \[19 mm\] 29-inch \[75 cm\] Circular Knitting Needles](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)

[Hometown USA](#) (Article #135). **Solids, Multis, Neons and Twists: 100% Acrylic,
Tweeds: 94% Acrylic, 6% Rayon;
package size: **Solids:** 5 oz. (142 g), 81 yd. (74 m)
Multis, Tweeds, Neons, and Twists: 4 oz. (113 g), 64 yd. (59 m)*



GAUGE:

5 stitches + 6 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1-6 of pattern, working with 3 strands of yarn held together.

When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

NOTES:

1. Afghan is worked in one piece with 3 strands of yarn held together.
2. When you work with multiple strands, just hold all the strands together and knit as usual.
3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of stitches. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.



AFGHAN

With 3 strands of yarn held together, cast on 50 stitches.

Rows 1-6: *Knit 5, purl 5; repeat from * to end of row.

Rows 7-12: *Purl 5, knit 5; repeat from * to end of row.

Rows 13-84: Repeat Rows 1-12.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
