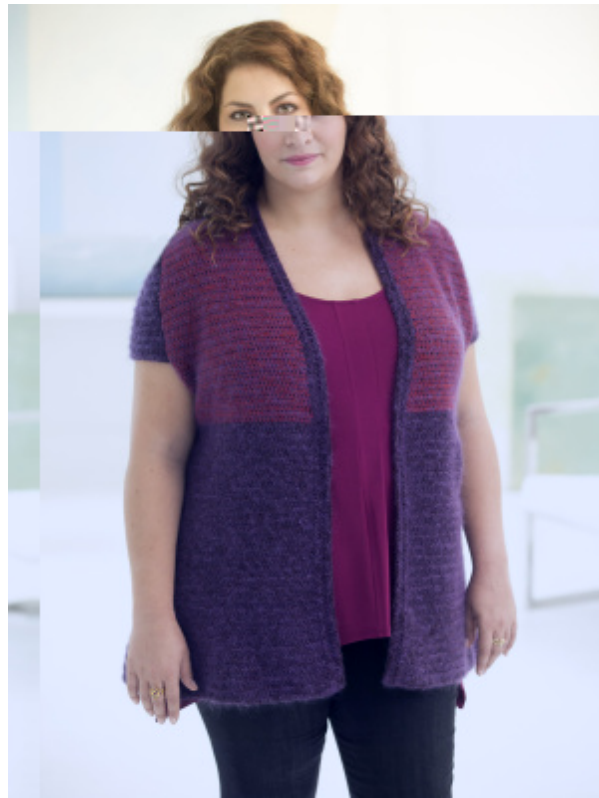

SKILL LEVEL: Easy + (Level 3)

SIZE: 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X

To Fit Bust 44-46 (48-50, 52-54, 56-58) in. (112-117 (122-127, 132-137, 142-147.5) cm)

Finished Hip 63 1/2 (66 1/2, 70 1/2, 73) in. (161.5 (169, 179, 185.5) cm)

Finished Length 30 1/2 (31, 31 1/2, 32) in. (77.5 (78.5, 80, 81.5) cm)

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

**LB Collection Superwash Merino (Article #486). 100% Superwash Merino Wool; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (306yds/280m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

14 hdc + 13 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) with 1 strand each of A and B held tog.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Vest is made in 5 pieces: Back, Left and Right Fronts, and 2 Cap Sleeves.
2. Pieces are worked with 1 strand of A held together with 1 strand of B or C.
3. This pattern includes some crocheter's lingo. When you see '- 12 sts' at the end of a sentence, this is the number of sts you will have after working that row.
4. Our pattern includes diagrams to help you visualize how the Vest is made and put together. Take the time to review the diagrams before you start crocheting. The Vest is easy to make, but having the big picture will make it even easier!

Curvy Girl Two-Tone Vest



BACK

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, ch 108 (114, 121, 127).

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – at the end of this row you will have 107 (113, 120, 126) hdc.

Rows 2-5 (2-4, 2-3, 2-3): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Shape Sides

Decrease Row: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 105 (111, 118, 124) hdc.

Next 5 (4, 3, 3) Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep Decrease Row – 103 (109, 116, 122) hdc.

Rep last 6 (5, 4, 4) rows 7 (9, 11, 11) more times – 89 (91, 94, 100) hdc rem.

Change Color, Continue Shaping

Change to 1 strand each of A and C held tog.

Next 5 (4, 3, 3) Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

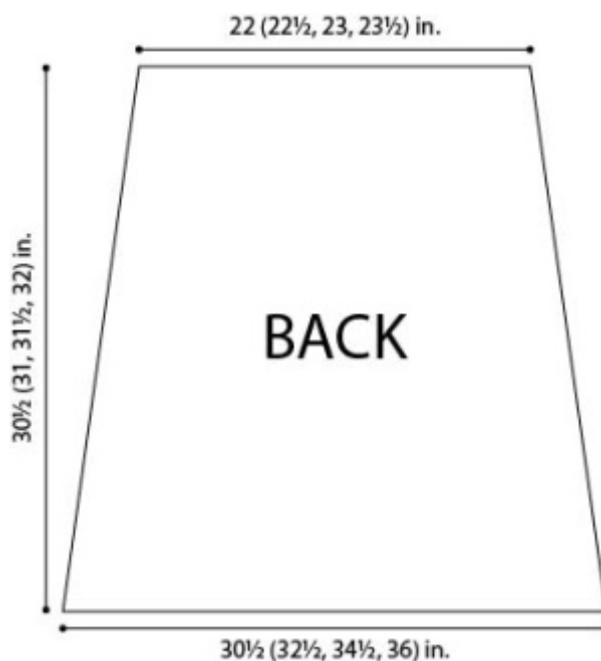
Rep Decrease Row – 87 (89, 92, 98) hdc.

Rep last 6 (5, 4, 4) rows 5 (5, 6, 8) more times – 77 (79, 80, 82) sts.

Next Row: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep last row until piece measures about 30 1/2 (31, 31 1/2, 32) in. (77.5 (78.5, 80, 81.5) cm) from beg.

Fasten off.



LEFT FRONT

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, ch 58 (61, 64, 66).

To make this part of the pattern clear, we've divided the instructions into separate sections. Be sure to follow the specific instructions for the size you are making.

Size 1 ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – at the end of this row you will have 57 hdc.

Rows 2-5: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Shape Side

Decrease Row (WS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 56 hdc.

Next 5 Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep Decrease Row – 55 hdc.

Rep last 6 rows 7 times – 48 hdc rem.

Change Color and Shape Neck

Change to 1 strand each of A and C held tog.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 2 (Neck Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 47 hdc.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2 – 46 hdc.

Row 5: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 6 (Neck and Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 44 hdc.

Rows 7-30: Rep last 6 rows 4 more times – 28 hdc.

Rows 31-35: Rep Rows 1-5 – 26 hdc at end of Row 34.

Row 36 (Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 25 hdc.

Row 37: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep last row until piece measures same as Back.

Fasten off.

Now, continue following the pattern, beg at **RIGHT FRONT** (below).

Size 2 ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – at the end of this row you will have 60 hdc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Shape Side

Decrease Row I (RS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 59 hdc.

Next 4 Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Decrease Row II (WS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 58 hdc.

Next 4 Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep last 10 rows 4 times – 50 hdc rem.

Rep Decrease Row I – 49 hdc.

Change Color and Shape Neck

Change to 1 strand each of A and C held tog.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 2 (Neck Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 48 hdc.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2 – 47 hdc.

Row 5 (Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 46 hdc.

Row 6: Rep Row 2 – 45 hdc.

Rows 7 and 8: Rep Rows 1 and 2 – 44 hdc.
Row

Rows 5-28: Rep last 4 rows 6 more times – 31 hdc.

Rows 29-31: Rep Rows 1-3 – 30 hdc at the end of Row 30.

Row 32 (Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 29 hdc.

Rows 33-35: Rep Row 1 three times.

Row 36: Rep Row 32 – 28 hdc.

Row 37: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep last row until piece measures same as Back.

Fasten off.

Now, continue following the pattern, beg at **RIGHT FRONT** (below).

RIGHT FRONT

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, ch 58 (61, 64, 66).

Note that instructions are divided into separate sections. Be sure to follow the specific instructions for the size you are making.

Size 1 ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – at the end of this row you will have 57 hdc.

Rows 2-5: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Shape Side

Decrease Row (WS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 56 hdc.

Next 5 Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep Decrease Row – 55 hdc.

Rep last 6 rows 7 times – 48 hdc rem.

Change Color and Shape Neck

Change to 1 strand each of A and C held tog.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 2 (Neck Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 47 hdc.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2 – 46 hdc.

Row 5: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 6 (Neck and Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 44 hdc.

Rows 7-30: Rep last 6 rows 4 more times – 28 hdc.

Rows 31-35: Rep Rows 1-5 – 26 hdc at end of Row 34.

Row 36 (Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 25 hdc.

Row 37: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep last row until piece measures same as Back.

Fasten off.

Now, continue following the pattern, beg at **CAP SLEEVES** (below).

Size 2 ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – at the end of this row you will have 60 hdc.

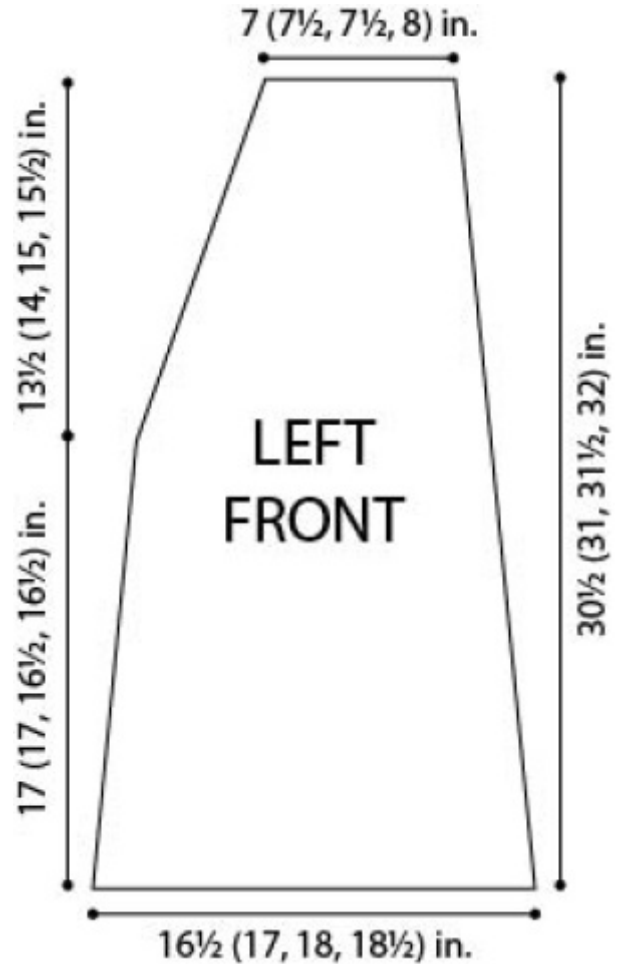
Rows 2-4: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Shape Side

Decrease Row I (RS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 59 hdc.

Next 4 Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Decrease Row II (WS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 58 hdc.



Next 4 Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep last 10 rows 4 times – 50 hdc.

Rep Decrease Row I – 49 hdc rem.

Change Color and Shape Neck

Change to 1 strand each of A and C held tog.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 2 (Neck Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 48 hdc.

Rows 3 and 4: Rep Rows 1 and 2 – 47 hdc.

Row 5 (Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 46 hdc.

Row 6: Rep Row 2 – 45 hdc.

Rows 7 and 8: Rep Rows 1 and 2 – 44 hdc.

Row 9: Rep Row 1.

Row 10 (Neck and Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 42 hdc.

Rows 11-30: Rep last 10 rows 2 more times – 28 hdc.

Rows 31 and 34: Rep Rows 1 and 2 twice – 26 hdc.

Row 35: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep last row until piece measures same as Back.

Fasten off.

Now, continue following the pattern, beg at **CAP SLEEVES** (below).

Size 3 ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – at the end of this row you will have 63 hdc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Shape Side

Decrease Row (WS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 62 hdc.

Next 3 Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep Decrease Row – 61 hdc.

Rep last 4 rows 11 times – 50 hdc rem.

Change Color and Shape Neck

Change to 1 strand each of A and C held tog.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 2 (Neck Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 49 hdc.

Row 3: Rep Row 1.

Row 4 (Neck and Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 47 hdc.

Rows 5-28: Rep last 4 rows 6 more times – 29 hdc.

Rows 29-32: Rep Rows 1 and 2 twice – 27 hdc.

Row 33: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep last row until piece measures same as Back.

Fasten off.

Now, continue following the pattern, beg at **CAP SLEEVES** (below).

Size 4 ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – at the end of this row you will have 65 hdc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Shape Side

Decrease Row (WS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 64 hdc.

Next 3 Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep Decrease Row – 63 hdc.

Rep last 4 rows 11 times – 52 hdc rem.

Change Color and Shape Neck

Change to 1 strand each of A and C held tog.

Row 1 (RS): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Row 2 (Neck Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 51 hdc.

Row 3: Rep Row 1.

Row 4 (Neck and Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st to last 3 sts, hdc2tog, hdc in top of beg ch – 49 hdc.

Rows 5-28: Rep last 4 rows 6 more times – 31 hdc.

Rows 29-31: Rep Rows 1-3 – 30 hdc.

Row 32 (Side Decrease): Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc2tog, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch – 29 hdc.

Rows 33-35: Rep Row 1 three times.

Row 36: Rep Row 32 – 28 hdc.

Row 37: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across working last hdc in top of beg ch.

Rep last row until piece measures same as Back.

Fasten off.

Now, continue following the pattern, beg at **CAP SLEEVES** (below).

CAP SLEEVES (make 2)

With 1 strand each of A and B held tog, ch 12.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc in 3rd ch from hook and in each ch across – 11 hdc.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in first st (increase made), 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each st to last 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, 2 hdc in top of beg ch – 15 hdc.

Rows 3-5: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in first st (increase made), hdc in each st to last st, 2 hdc in top of beg ch – 21 hdc.

Row 6: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across.

Row 7: Rep Row 3 – 23 hdc.

Rows 8-15 (17, 19, 21): Rep last 2 rows 4 (5, 6, 7) times – 31 (33, 35, 37) hdc.

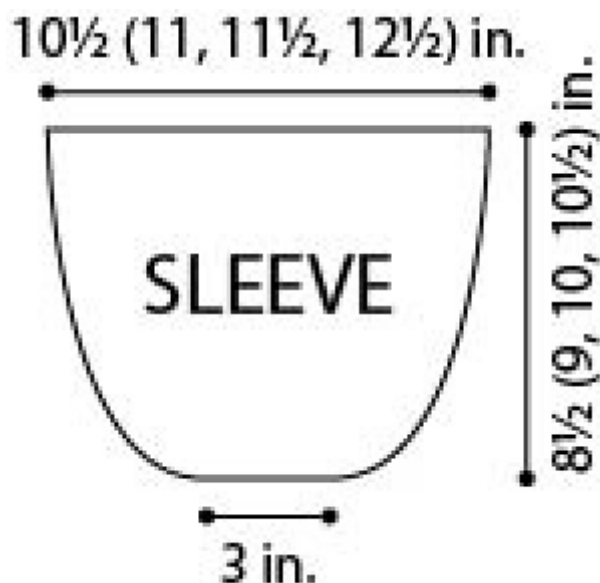
Next 3 Rows: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across.

Next Row: Rep Row 3 – 33 (35, 37, 39) hdc.

Rep last 4 rows twice – 37 (39, 41, 43) hdc.

Next Row: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, hdc in each st across.

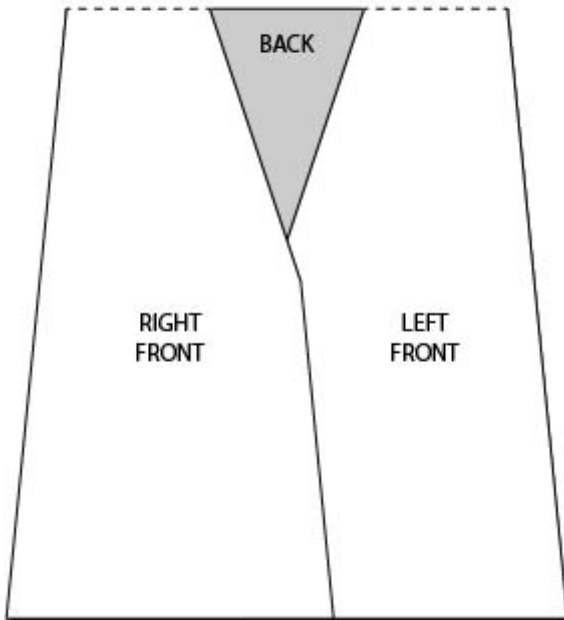
Fasten off.



FINISHING

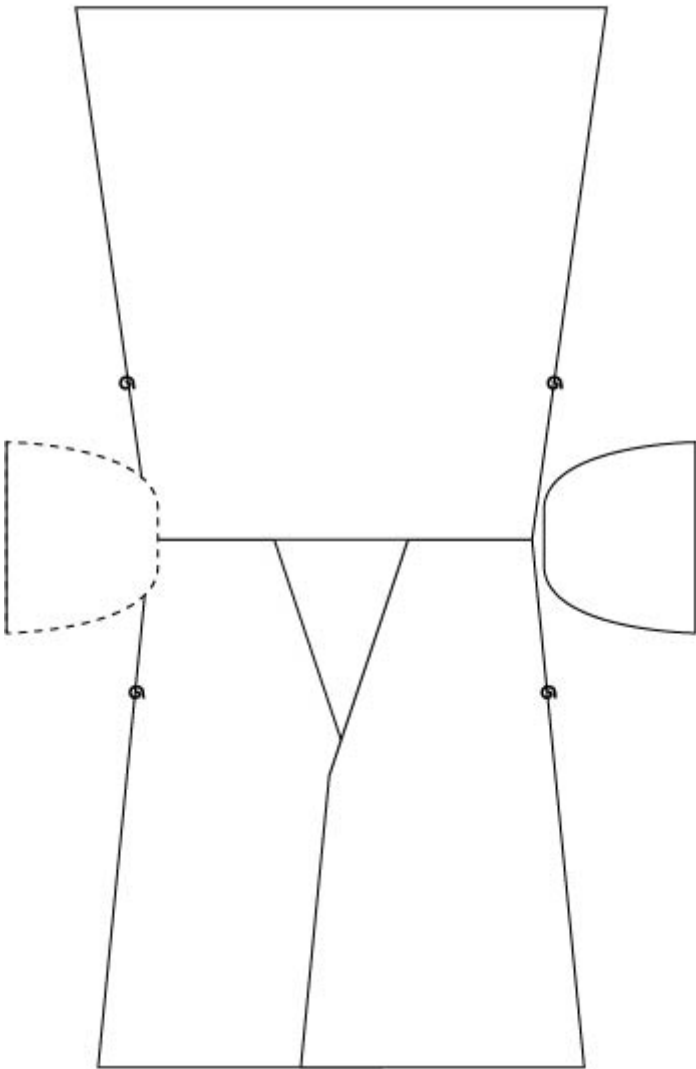
Step 1: Sew shoulder seams.

STEP 1



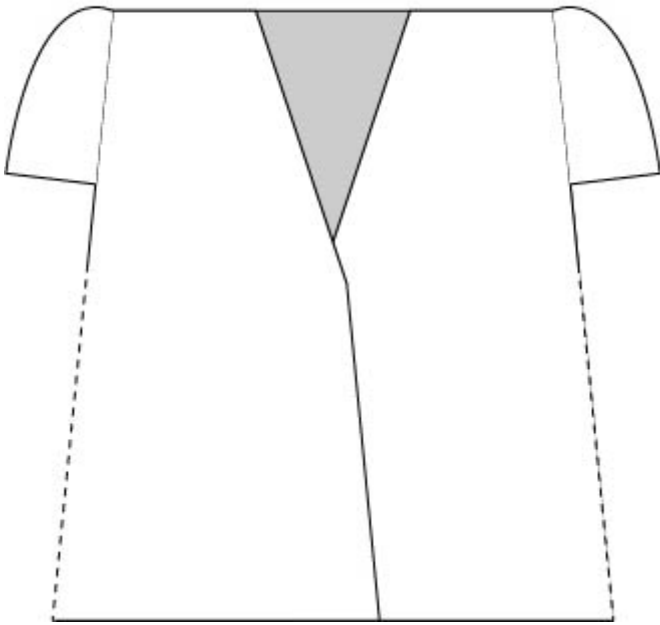
Step 2: Place markers on side edges of Fronts and Back 9 (9 1/2, 10 1/2, 11) in. (23 (24, 26.5, 28) cm) below shoulder seams. Matching the center of the top of the Sleeve to the shoulder seam of the Vest, sew Cap Sleeves to Vest between markers.

STEP 2



Step 3: Sew Fronts to Back at sides, beg at lower edge and sewing for about 16 1/2 in. (42 cm). Before sewing, we suggest you try the Vest on to determine how far to sew to create a look that's flattering to you. Upper portion of side and Cap Sleeve is left unsewn for armhole.

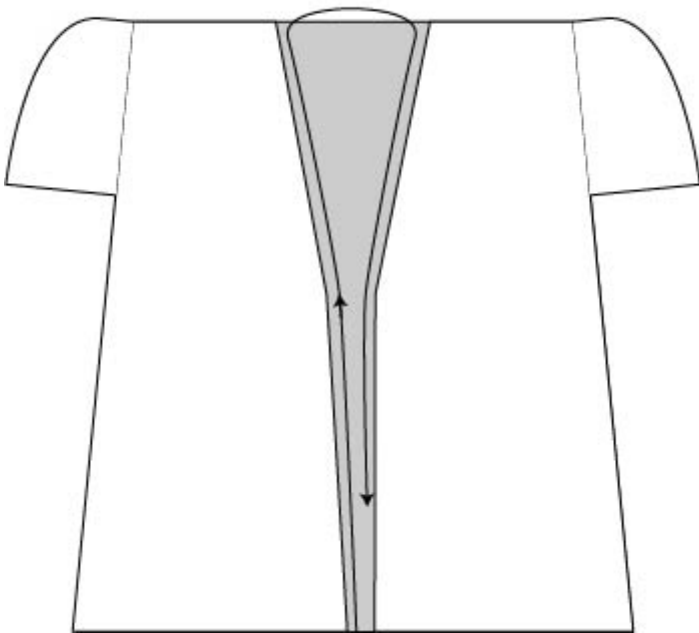
STEP 3



Step 4: Front and Neck Bands

From RS join 1 strand each of A and B held tog with a sl st in lower front corner so that you are ready to work up front edge. Work sc evenly spaced up front edge, across back neck, and down other front edge. Fasten off.

STEP 4



Weave in ends.
