GAUGE:

8 sc = 4 in. (10 cm) with larger hook.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES:

1. Five Panels are worked separately, then sewn together to make Skirt.

2. Trees, Candy Canes, Tassels and other embellishments are worked separately then sewn to the completed Skirt.

3. When you see "– 12 sts" in the instructions, this lets you know how many sts you will have at the end of that specific row.

TREE SKIRT PANELS (make 5)

With larger hook and A, ch 37.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 36 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 3 (Decrease): Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each sc to last 2 sc, sc2tog – you will have 34 sts at the end of this row.

Row 4: Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Rows 5-18: Rep Rows 3 and 4 – 20 sts at the end of Row 18.

Rows 19-21: Rep Row 4.

Note: An sc border is worked on each color section of Panel. For this border, the designer worked one sc per each row – but your tension may vary! Work as many sc's as you like to create a tidy edge – then just make a note of the number of sc's you worked and be sure to work the same number on the other Panels. **Border Row (RS):** Turn to work along side edge of Panel.

Work 21 sc evenly spaced along side edge down to foundation ch; turn to work along opposite side of foundation ch and work 36 sc evenly spaced across lower edge; turn to work along side edge and work 21 sc evenly spaced along side edge.

Fasten off.

From WS, join B with sl st in last st of Row 21.

Row 22 (WS): Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 23: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each sc to last 2 sc, sc2tog – 18 sc.

Rows 24-31: Rep Rows 22 and 23 – 10 sts at the end of Row 31.

Border Row (RS): Turn to work along side edge of Panel and work 10 sc evenly spaced along ends of Rows 31-22.

Fasten off.

From RS, join B with sl st in end of Row 22. Work 10 sc evenly spaced along ends of Rows 22-31. Fasten off.

From WS, join C with sl st in last st of Row 31.

Row 32 (WS): Ch 1, turn, sc in each sc across.

Row 33: Ch 1, turn, sc2tog, sc in each sc to last 2 sc, sc2tog – 8 sc.

Rows 34-37: Rep Rows 32 and 33 – 4 sts at the end of Row 37.

Border Row (RS): Turn to work along side edge, work 6 sc evenly spaced across ends of Rows 37-32. Fasten off.

From RS, join C with sl st in end of Row 32. Work 6 sc evenly spaced across ends of Rows 32-37. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew 5 Panels tog along sides, matching color sections and leaving one seam unsewn.

Candy Canes (make 3)

Note: Candy Canes are made with 3 strands held together of the red and white yarns from D yarn package. Wind the red and white yarns, or colors of your choice, into 3 smaller balls before beginning. With smaller hook and 3 strands of red held together, ch 40.

Row 1: Work 4 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 2 sc in next ch and in each ch to last ch, sl st in last ch. Fasten off.

Rep with 3 strands of white held together to make a second piece.

Twist red and white strips around each other to make Candy Cane.

Sew a few sts through strips to hold the twist.

Sew a Candy Cane to center of first, third and fifth Panels.

Trees (make 2)

With smaller hook and C, ch 28.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 3 ch, hdc in next 4 ch, sc in next 4 ch, 3 sc in next ch, sc in next 4 ch, hdc in next 4 ch, dc in next 4 ch.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 4, turn, tr in next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, sc in next 3 sts, 3 sc in next st, sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 3 sts, dc in next 3 sts, tr in next 3 sts, tr in top of beg ch.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Fold Tree in half along foundation ch and with long yarn tail, sew together to make Tree.

Trunk (make 2)

With smaller hook and B, ch 8.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 7 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each sc across.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, working through both loops, sc in each sc across.

Rows 4 and 5: Rep Rows 1 and 2.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Stars (make 2)

Note: Stars are made with 2 strands held together of color of your choice from D yarn package.

With smaller hook and 2 strands of red held together, ch 2.

Rnd 1: Work 5 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook (picot made), sl st in same sc as joining, *sl st in next sc, ch 2, sc in 2nd ch from hook, sl st in same sc; rep from * 3 more times; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Sew a Tree to centers of second and fourth Panels. Sew a Trunk to base of each Tree and a Star to the top. Top Edging

From RS with larger hook, join C with a sl st at top corner of Tree Skirt. Work sc evenly spaced around top edge.

Fasten off.

Lower Edging

From RS with larger hook, join A with a sl st at at lower corner of Tree Skirt. Work sc evenly spaced around lower edge.

Fasten off.

Ties (make 6: 4 with C and 2 with B)

With larger hook, ch 18, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

With yarn tails sew Ties to open edges of Skirt – sewing C Ties to top and lower edge of C section of Skirt and B Ties to lower edge of B section.

Tassels (make 4: with colors as desired from D yarn package)

Wrap yarn 40 times around the 5 in. (12.5 cm) side of cardboard. Cut a 12 in. (30.5 cm) length of yarn and thread into blunt needle. Insert needle under all strands at upper edge of cardboard. Pull tightly and knot securely near strands. Cut yarn loops at lower edge of cardboard.

Tassel Wrap

Cut another 12 in. (30.5 cm) piece of yarn.

Wrap around Tassel 1 in. (2.5 cm) below top edge and knot.

Trim Tassel ends evenly.

Sew a Tassel to each Panel seam along lower edge of Skirt.
