Cotton: 100% Cotton. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Gentle Cycle, Do Not Bleach, Dry Flat, Low Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

Acrylic: 100% Acrylic. **Care:** Machine Wash and Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Tumble Dry Normal, Dry Clean and Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.

Metallic: 96% Acrylic, 4% Metallic Polyester. **Care:** Machine Wash Cool, Lay Flat to Dry, Do Not Bleach, Do Not Iron, Dry Clean Any Solvent Except Trichloroethylene.; package size:

MATERIALS

- 601-650 [Lion Brand Bonbons Yarn: Party](#)
1 Ball
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)
- Additional Materials
3 1/4 in. (8.5 cm)
plastic canvas
precut stars, 2



GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

NOTES:

1. Stars are embroidered then sewn together to make a double-sided ornament or package tie-on.
2. Embroidery is worked in simple stitches with a single strand of yarn. Follow the stitch guide for how to work the stitches and follow the chart for stitch placement and yarn color.
3. As you finish a row of embroidery, weave the yarn tail through the stitches on the back of the plastic canvas to secure it before you cut it.

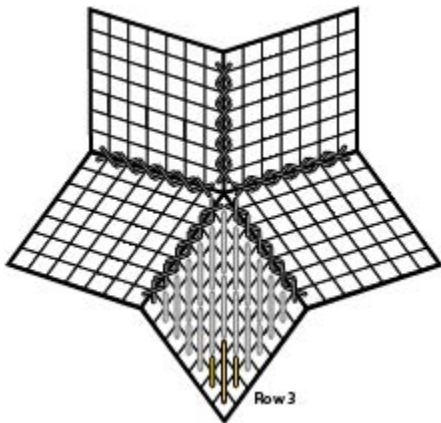
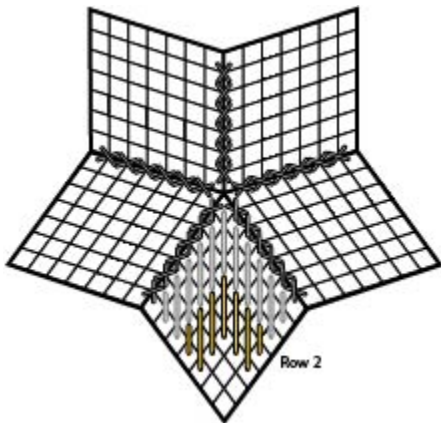
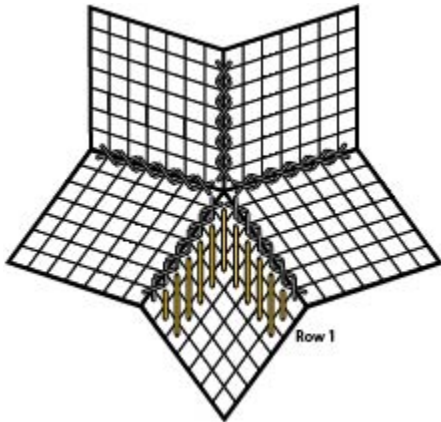
STAR (make 2)

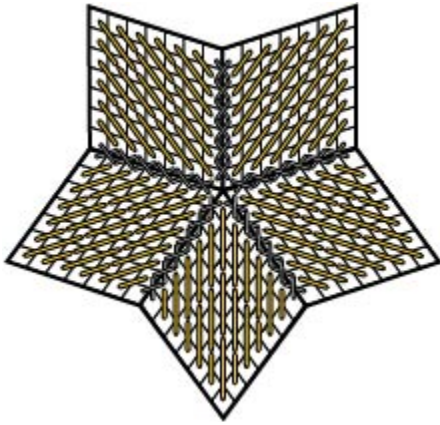
Embroidery

Notes: 1. Leave the thicker border threads around the outside edge of the star shape unworked.

2. Use 1 strand each of purple and silver held together for A, and 1 strand each of orange and gold held together for B, or colors of your choice.

With A (1 strand each of purple and silver) or colors of your choice, and following chart, work cross stitches over the 5 threads between the star segments.





✕ With A, work Cross stitch

▬ With B, work Straight stitch over 2 intersections of threads

▬ With B, work Straight stitch over 1 intersection of threads

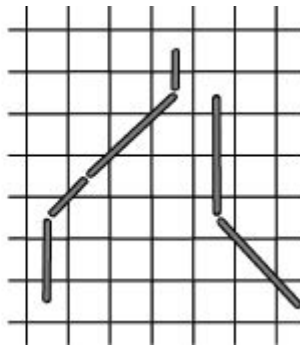
Note: For Rows 1-3, the first and last stitches of each row are worked over only 1 intersection of threads.

Row 1: With B (1 strand each of gold and orange) or colors of your choice, and following chart, work straight stitches over 2 intersecting threads.

Row 2: With B or colors of your choice, and following chart, work straight stitches over the next 2 intersecting threads.

Row 3: With B or colors of your choice, and following chart, work straight stitches over the remaining intersections.

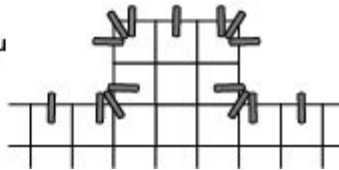
Straight Stitch - This stitch can cover one or more intersections or threads and can be vertical, horizontal, or slant in either direction.



FINISHING

Hold the 2 stars with wrong sides together. With A or colors of your choice, work overcast stitch through both layers around outside edge to join.

Overcast Stitch - This stitch is used to cover the edge of the canvas or to join pieces of canvas. You may need to go through the same hole more than once to get even coverage on the edge, especially at the corners.



Thread 1 strand each of colors of your choice, through one point of the Star and knot the ends to make a hanging loop. Trim ends.
