## GAUGE:

8 pattern reps + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Puff pattern used for Left Back and Front, with larger hook. **Note:** One pattern rep of Puff pattern consists of one Puff and the following ch-1 sp.

2 pattern reps = about 3 1/2 in. (9 cm); 9 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Lace pattern used for Right Back and Front, with larger hook. **Note:** One pattern rep of Lace pattern consists of a 5-dc group and the following ch 2, sc, ch 2.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

## STITCH EXPLANATION:

**Puff (Puff stitch)** Yarn over, insert hook in indicated st, yarn over and draw up a loop, (yarn over, insert hook in *same* st, yarn over and draw up a loop) 2 times, yarn over, draw through all loops on hook.

V-st (V-stitch) (Dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st.

#### **NOTES:**

- 1. Top is made from 4 pieces: Left Back, Left Front, Right Back, and Right Front.
- 2. Left Back and Left Front are worked the same, except for neck shaping, in a Puff st pattern. Right Back and Right Front are worked the same, except for neck shaping, in a Lace pattern.
- 3. Center diagonal edges of Left Back and Right Back are crocheted together to form the Back. Center diagonal edges of Left Front and Right Front are crocheted together to form Front.
- 4. Shoulder and side seams are sewn.







#### **LEFT BACK**

With larger hook, ch 32 (42, 50).

Row 1 (WS): Puff in 4th ch from hook (skipped 3 ch count as first dc), \*ch 1, sk next ch, Puff in next ch; rep from \* to last 2 ch, ch 1, dc in last ch - you will have 14 (19, 23) pattern reps in this row.

Row 2: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 1, Puff in beg ch-sp, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch - 15 (20, 24) pattern reps.

Row 4 and 5: Rep Rows 2 and 3 - 16 (21, 25) pattern reps at the end of Row 5. Rows 6-13: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch.

Rows 14 and 15: Rep Rows 2 and 3 - 17 (22, 26) pattern reps at the end of Row

Rows 16-19: Rep Row 6 four times.

Rows 20-23: Rep Rows 2 and 3 twice - 19 (24, 28) pattern reps at the end of Row

Rows 24-29: Rep Row 6 six times.

Rows 30 and 31: Rep Rows 2 and 3 - 20 (25, 29) pattern reps at the end of Row

Row 32: Rep Row 2.

# **Shape Armhole**

Row 33: Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 7 (17, 25) sts and ch-1 sps, ch 3 (counts as dc), Puff in next ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 1, Puff in beg ch-sp, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch - 18 pattern reps.

Row 34: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, dc in last ch-1 sp - 17 pattern reps.

Row 35: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 1, Puff in beg ch-sp, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

Row 36: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to last ch-1 sp, ch 1, dc in last ch-1 sp; leave rem sts unworked - 16


Row 37: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 38: Rep Row 36 - 15 pattern reps.

Rows 39-46 (48, 50): Rep Row 37 for 8 (10, 12) times.

Row 47 (49, 51): Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, (ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp; leave rem sts unworked for neck - 4 pattern reps.

Fasten off.



#### **LEFT FRONT**

**Note:** Row 1 is a RS row on this piece.

Work as for Left Back until Row 38 has been completed.

Shape Neck


**Row 39 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, (ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp) 8 times, dc in next Puff; leave rem sts unworked – 9 pattern reps.

**Row 40:** Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 5 sts, ch 3 (counts as dc), Puff in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch – 6 pattern reps.

**Row 41:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 42:** Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 3 sts, ch 3 (counts as dc), Puff in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch – pattern reps. **Row 43:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, (ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 sp; leave rem sts unworked – 4 pattern reps.

**Rows 44-47 (49, 51):** Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, Puff in first ch-1 sp, (ch 1, Puff in next ch-1 sp) 3 times, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch. Fasten off.



#### **RIGHT BACK**

With larger hook, ch 50 (58, 66).

**Row 1 (WS):** Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), \*ch 2, sk next 2 ch, dc in next ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next 2 ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* to last 6 ch, ch 2, sk next 2 ch, dc in next ch, 3 dc in next ch, dc in last 2 ch - 6 (7, 8) pattern reps.

**Row 2:** Ch 3 (counts as dc in this row and all following rows), turn, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, \*ch 2, sk next 2 ch-2 sps, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc; rep from \* to beg ch, ch 2, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 3:** Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 4:** Ch 5 (counts as dc, ch 2 in this row and in all following rows), turn, sk first sc, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to last 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 5:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch-1 sp, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, 5 dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 6:** Ch 3, turn, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to last 5 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch.

Row 7: Ch 5, turn, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 8:** Ch 5, turn, sk first sc, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to beg ch, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch - 5 (6, 7) pattern reps.

**Row 9:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, 5 dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 10:** Ch 3, turn, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to last 2 dc, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 11:** Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 12:** Ch 5, turn, sk first sc, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to last 3 dc, (dc in next dc,

ch 1) twice, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 13:** Ch 5, turn, sc in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, 5 dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 14:** Ch 3, turn, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to last dc, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 15:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 16:** Ch 5, turn, sk first sc, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to last 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 17:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next st, \*5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, ch 2; rep from \* to last 3 dc, 5 dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 18:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, \*ch 2, sk next sc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc; rep from \* to last 2 dc, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 19:** Ch 5, turn, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 20:** Ch 5, turn, sk first sc, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to beg ch, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch - 4 (5, 6) pattern reps.

Row 21: Ch 3, turn, 2 dc in first ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, 5 dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 22:** Ch 3, turn, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to last 3 dc, (dc in next dc, ch 1) twice, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 23:** Ch 5, turn, sc in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 24:** Ch 5, turn, sk first sc, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* beg ch, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 25:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, 5 dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 26:** Ch 3, turn, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to last 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 27:** Ch 3, turn, \*5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of V-st, ch 2; rep from \* to last 3 dc, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 28:** Ch 5, turn, sk first sc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, \*ch 2, sk next sc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc; rep from \* to beg ch, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 29:** Ch 5, turn, sc in ch-1 sp of first V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, 5 dc in beg ch-sp sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 30:** Ch 3, turn, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to beg ch, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 31:** Ch 3, turn, 4 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 32:** Ch 5, turn, sk first sc, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to last 5 dc, (dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc) twice, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 33:** Ch 5, turn, sc in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, 5 dc in beg ch-sp, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 34:** Ch 3, turn, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to beg ch, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.


**Row 35:** Ch 3, turn, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of next V-st; rep from \* to last 3 dc, ch 2, sc in top of beg ch.

# **Shape Armhole**

**Row 36:** Ch 1, turn, sl st in first 11 (21, 31) sts and chs, ch 5, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to last 4 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 37:** Ch 5, turn, sc in first ch-1 sp, \*ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-1 sp of V-st; rep from \* to last ch-sp, ch 2, 2 dc in last ch-sp.

**Row 38:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc; rep from \* to beg ch, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch - 2 pattern reps.



**Row 39:** Ch 5, turn, sc in ch-1 sp of V-st, ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-1 sp of V-st, ch 2, 2 dc in last ch-2 sp, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 40:** Ch 3, turn, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 41:** Ch 3, turn, 4 dc in ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in ch-1 sp of V-st, ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 42:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 43:** Ch 5, turn, sc in ch-1 sp of V-st, ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-1 sp of V-st, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 44:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

Rep Rows 41-44 until piece measures same length as Back to neck.

Last Row: Ch 1, turn, work sc evenly spaced across row.

Fasten off.

# **RIGHT FRONT**

Note: Row 1 is a RS row on this piece.

Work as for Right Back until Row 42 has been completed - 2 pattern reps.

**Row 43:** Ch 1, turn, sl st to ch-1 sp of first V-st, sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-1 sp of next V-st, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 44:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk next sc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next ch-2 sp.

**Row 45:** Ch 5, turn, sc in ch-1 sp of V-st, ch 2, 5 dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 46:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk next dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, sk next sc, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch.

**Row 47:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch-1 sp of V-st, ch 2, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, dc in top of beg ch.

**Row 48:** Ch 3, turn, dc in next dc, ch 2, V-st in next dc, dc in top of beg ch. Rep Rows 45-48 until piece measures same length as Back to shoulder.

Last Row: Ch 1, turn, work sc evenly spaced across row.

Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

#### **Trim Diagonal Edges and Join Pieces**

From RS with smaller hook, join yarn with a sl st to Left Back at beg of diagonal edge.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch 1, work sc as evenly spaced as possible across diagonal edge to neck edge.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st to end of row.

Fasten off.

Rep trim along diagonal edge of Left Front, Right Back, and Right Front.

With RS together, match diagonal edges of Left and Right Back. Join yarn with a sl st at beg of diagonal edge. Working through both thicknesses, sl st across to join pieces along diagonal edge.

Fasten off.

Rep to join Front pieces.

Sew shoulder seams.

#### **Neck Edging**

From RS with smaller hook, join yarn with a sl st in neck edge at shoulder seam.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, work sc as evenly spaced as possible around neck; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Sew side seams.


#### **Armhole Edging**

From RS with smaller hook, join yarn with a sl st at side seam. Work around armhole same as neck edging. Rep edging around opposite armhole.

#### **Lower Edge**

From RS with smaller hook, working along opposite side of foundation ch, join yarn with a sl st at side seam. Work around lower edge same as neck edging.

Weave in ends.
