## Lion Brand® Color Clouds

### Cushy Rib Scarf

Pattern Number: L50245

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy + (Level 3)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 6 x 54 in. (15 x 137 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- 546-102 Lion Brand Color Clouds: Alchemists Aqua  
2 Balls
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 15 [10 mm]
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

*\*Color Clouds (Article #546). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (55yds/50m) pull skeins*



#### GAUGE:

9 sts = about 6 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1 and 2.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece in an easy rib pattern.
2. The knit stitches in the rib pattern are always worked into the row below. This means that on Row 2 you will be knitting into the stitches of Row 1.
3. 'With yarn in front' and 'with yarn in back', refers to the side of the piece as you work across the row.

#### SCARF

Cast on 9 sts.

Knit one row.

**Row 1:** Slip 1 as if to knit with yarn in back, \*k1 into next stitch in the row below, p1; rep from \* across.

**Row 2:** Slip 1 as if to purl with yarn in front, \*p1, k1 into next stitch in the row below; rep from \* to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until about 18 in. (45.5 cm) of yarn remains.

Bind off.

#### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
