

Free Crochet Pattern LION BRAND[®] SHAWL IN A BALL ESSEX STREET TRIANGLE SHAWL

Pattern Number: L50256 SB



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SKILL LEVEL – Easy +

SIZES

Finished Width 66 in. (167.5 cm), across top edge **Finished Length** 28 in (71 cm), from top center to lower point

MATERIALS

• LION BRAND® SHAWL IN A BALL (Art. #828)

#200 Community Coral 1 ball or color of your choice

- LION BRAND[®] crochet hook size I-9 (5.5 mm)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND[®] large-eyed blunt needle



GAUGE

4 pattern reps = about 4 1/2 in. (11.5 cm); 5 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm). Note: One pattern rep consists of a ch-5 sp or a 5-dc group and the following sc. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

NOTES

- 1. Shawl is worked in one piece beg at center back neck.
- 2. Increases are worked in every row to shape Shawl.
- 3. The pattern stitch used on this Shawl is easy to do! For those who find a visual helpful, we've included a diagram.

SHAWL

Ch 5; join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

Row 1: Ch 6 (counts as dc, ch 3 in this row and all following rows), sc in ring, ch 5, sc in ring, ch 3, dc in ring – you will have 2 dc, 2 sc, and 3 ch-sps at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, ch 5, (sc, ch 5, sc) in center ch-5 sp, ch 5, sc in last ch-sp, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch - 2 dc, 4 sc, and 5 ch-sps.

Row 3: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-sp, ch 5, (sc, ch 5, sc) in center ch-5 sp, place a marker in center ch-5 sp just made, (ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch – 2 dc, 6 sc, and 7 ch-sps.

Row 4: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, *ch 5, sc in next ch-sp; rep from * to marked center ch-5 sp, ch 5, (sc, ch 5, sc) in center ch-5 sp and move marker to ch-5 sp just made, **ch 5, sc in next ch-sp; rep from ** across working last sc in last ch-sp, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch – 2 dc, 8 sc, and 9 ch-sps.

Row 5: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, 5 dc in next sc, sc in next ch-sp, (ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice, 5 dc in next sc, (sc, ch 5, sc) in center ch-5 sp and move marker to ch-5 sp just made, 5 dc in next sc, sc in next ch-sp, (ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice, 5 dc in next sc, sc in last ch-sp, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch – 2 dc, four 5-dc groups, 10 sc, and 7 ch-sps.

Row 6: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, (ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, ch 5, (sc, ch 5, sc) in center ch-5 sp and move marker to ch-5 sp just made, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, (ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, (ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch – 2 dc, 12 sc, and 13 ch-sps.

Row 7: Rep Row 4 – 2 dc, 14 sc, and 15 ch-sps

Row 8: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, 5 dc in next sc, *sc in next ch-sp, (ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice, 5 dc in next sc; rep from * to marked center ch-5 sp, (sc, ch 5, sc) in center ch-5 sp and move marker to ch-5 sp just made, 5 dc in next sc, **sc in next ch-sp, (ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice, 5 dc in next sc; rep from ** to last ch-sp, sc in last ch-sp, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch – 2 dc, six 5-dc groups, 16 sc, and 11 ch-sps.

Row 9: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, *(ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group; rep from * to marked center ch-5 sp, ch 5, (sc, ch 5, sc) in center ch-5 sp and move marker to ch-5 sp just made, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, **(ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group; rep from ** to last ch-sp, ch 5, sc in last ch-sp, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch – 2 dc, 18 sc, and 19 ch-sps.

Row 10: Rep Row 4 – 2 dc, 20 sc, and 21 ch-sps.

Rows 11 and 12: Rep Rows 8 and 9 – 2 dc, 24 sc, and 25 ch-sps at the end of Row 12.

Rows 13 and 14: Rep Rows 7 and 8 – 2 dc, ten 5-dc groups, 28 sc, and 19 ch-sps.

Row 15: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, 5 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, 5 dc in next sc, *sc in next ch-sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-sp, 5 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, 5 dc in next sc; rep from * to marked center ch-5 sp, (sc, ch 5, sc) in center ch-5 sp and move marker to ch-5 sp just made, 5 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, 5 dc in next sc, **sc in next ch-sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-sp, 5 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, 5 dc in next sc, **sc in next ch-sp, ch 5, sc in next ch-sp, 5 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, 5 dc in next sc; rep from ** to last ch-sp, sc in last ch-sp, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch – 2 dc, twenty 5-dc groups, 30 sc, and 11 ch-sps.

Row 16: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, 5 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, *ch 5, sc in next ch-sp, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, 5 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group; rep from * to marked center ch-5 sp, ch 5, (sc, ch 5, sc) in center ch-5 sp and move marker to ch-5 sp just made, **ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, 5 dc in next sc, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, ch 5, sc in next ch-sp; rep from ** working last sc in last ch-sp, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch – 2 dc, ten 5-dc groups, 32 sc, and 23 ch-sps.

Row 17: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, *ch 5, sc in next ch-sp, ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, ch 5, sc in next ch-sp; rep from * to marked center ch-5 sp, ch 5, (sc, ch 5, sc) in center ch-5 sp and move marker to ch-5 sp just made, ch 5, sc in next ch-sp, **ch 5, sc in center dc of next 5-dc group, (ch 5, sc in next ch-sp) twice; rep from ** across working last sc in last ch-sp, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch of beg ch – 2 dc, 34 sc, and 35 ch-sps.

Row 18: Rep Row 4 – 2 dc, 36 sc, and 37 ch-sps.

Rows 19-22: Rep Rows 7-10 – 2 dc, 44 sc, and 45 ch-sps at the end of Row 22.

Rows 23-37: Rep Rows 8-22 – 2 dc, 74 sc, and 75 ch-sps at the end of Row 37.

Do NOT fasten off.

Edging Round: Ch 6, turn, sc in first ch-sp, 5 dc in next sc, *sc in next ch-sp, 5 dc in next sc; rep from * to marked center ch-5 sp, (sc, hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc, sc) in center ch-5 sp and remove marker, **5 dc in next sc, sc in next ch-sp; rep from ** across working last sc in last ch-sp, (hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc, sc) in 3rd ch of beg ch, do not turn; work 3 hdc in each ch-sp and in beg ring across long top edge working last 3-hdc group in beg ch-sp, (sc, hdc, dc, tr, dc, hdc, sc) in 3rd ch of beg ch; join with sl st in first sc – Thirty-seven 5-dc groups along each side edge, and seventy-seven 3-hdc groups along top edge.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Blocking


Dampen Shawl thoroughly. Spread a towel onto a flat surface, then lay Shawl onto towel and smooth into shape. Gently shape Shawl to match finished measurements. Use blocking wires if desired to further shape Shawl. Allow to air dry.

Weave in ends.
