MATERIALS

- 828-202 Lion Brand Shawl in a Ball: Calming Desert
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size I-9
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Shawl in a Ball (Article #828). 58% cotton, 39% acrylic, 3% other; package size: 5.30oz/150.00 gr. (481yds/440m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

1 Square = about 5 1/4 x 5 1/4 in. (13.5 x 13.5 cm).



When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:


RV (raised 3-dc group) Tr in indicated st or sp, 2 dc in first horizontal bar of tr just made (see diagram).

Raised 3-dc



NOTES:

1. Lacy Squares and Triangles are joined as you work them to make the Shawl.
2. Follow the diagram for direction of work.
3. The pattern stitch for each Square and Triangle is easy! For those who find a visual helpful, we've included diagrams.
4. A border is worked around the entire outside edge of the Shawl.



SQUARE I



Ch 21.

Row 1: Work RV in 7th ch from hook (6 skipped ch count as 2 base ch and first tr), *ch 1, sk next 3 ch, RV in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk next ch, tr in last ch – you will have 4 RV, 3 ch-1 sps, and 2 tr.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 5, sk next RV, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across working last sc in top of beg ch – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps at the end of this row.

Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, RV in first ch-5 sp, *ch 1, sk next sc, RV in next ch-5 sp; rep from * across, tr in last sc – 4 RV, 3 ch-1 sps, and 2 tr.

Rows 4-7: Rep Rows 2 and 3 twice.
Do NOT fasten off.




SQUARE II

Row 1: Ch 21, turn, RV in 7th ch from hook (6 skipped ch count as 2 base ch and first tr), *ch 1, sk next 3 ch, RV in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk next ch, tr in last ch; sl st in first ch-1 sp of last row of Square I – 4 RV, 3 ch-1 sps, and 2 tr.

Row 2: Rep Row 2 of Square I – 5 sc and 4 ch-1 sps.

Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as first tr), turn, RV in first ch-5 sp, *ch 1, sk next sc, RV in next ch-5 sp; rep from * across, tr in last sc; sl st in next ch-1 sp of last row of Square I – 4 RV, 3 ch-1 sps, and 2 tr.

Rows 4-7: Rep Rows 2 and 3 twice, working last sl st of Row 7 in top of beg ch-4 of last row of Square I.
Do NOT fasten off.




SQUARE III

Row 1: Working in ends of rows along side edge of Square I, ch 4 (counts as first tr), RV in end of Row 7, *ch 1, sk next sc row, RV in end of next row; rep from * 2 more times, tr in corner of Square I – 4 RV, 3 ch-1 sps, and 2 tr.

Rows 2-7: Rep Rows 2-7 of Square I.


Do NOT fasten off.



SQUARE IV

Work same as Square II, joining to last row of Square III at the end of each odd-numbered row.


Do NOT fasten off.



SQUARE V

Row 1: Working in ends of rows along side edge of Square III, ch 4 (counts as first tr), RV in end of Row 7, *ch 1, sk next sc row, RV in end of next row; rep from * 2 more times, tr in corner of Square III; sl st in first ch-1 sp of last row of Square II – 4 RV, 3 ch-1 sps, and 2 tr.


Rows 2-7: Work same as Rows 2-7 of Square II, joining to last row of Square II at the end of each odd-numbered row. Do NOT fasten off.



SQUARE VI

Work same as Square III, beg along side edge of Square II.

Do NOT fasten off.



SQUARE VII

Work same as Square II, joining to last row of Square VI at the end of each odd-numbered row.
Do NOT fasten off.

SQUARE VIII

Work same as Square V, beg along side edge of Square VI and joining to last row of Square V at the end of each odd-numbered row.
Do NOT fasten off.

SQUARE IX

Work same as Square V, beg along side edge of Square V and joining to last row of Square IV at the end of each odd-numbered row.
Do NOT fasten off.

SQUARE X

Work same as Square III, beg along side edge of Square IV.
Do NOT fasten off.

SQUARES XI-XXVIII

Continue as established until a total of 28 Squares have been worked.
Refer to diagram for placement of each Square and direction of work.
Do NOT fasten off.

TRIANGLE I

Row 1: Ch 19, tr in 5th ch from hook (4 skipped ch count as first tr), *ch 1, sk next 3 ch, RV in next ch; rep from * to last 2 ch, sk next ch, tr in last ch; sl st in first ch-1 sp of Square XXVIII – 3 RV, 3 ch-1 sps, and 3 tr.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, *ch 5, sk next RV, sc in next ch-1 sp; rep from * across; leave last tr and beg ch unworked – 4 sc and 3 ch-5 sps.


Row 3: Ch 4 (counts as first tr), tr in first ch-5 sp, *ch 1, RV in next ch-5 sp; rep from * across, tr in last sc; sl st in next ch-1 sp of Square XXVIII – 2 RV, 2 ch-1 sps, and 3 tr.

Rows 4 and 5: Rep Rows 2 and 3 – 1 RV, 1 ch-1 sp, and 3 tr at the end of Row 5.

Row 6: Ch 1, turn, sc in first st, ch 5, sk next RV, sc in next ch-1 sp; leave last tr and beg ch unworked – 2 sc and 1 ch-5 sp.

Row 7: Ch 4, turn, tr in ch-5 sp, tr in last sc; sl st in corner of Square XXVIII – 3 tr.

Do NOT fasten off.




TRIANGLES II-VII

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same sp as last sl st made; working in ends of rows along side edge of next Square, ch 4 (counts as first tr), tr in end of Row 7, *ch 1, sk next sc row, RV in end of next row; rep from * 2 more times, tr in corner of same Square; sl st in first ch-1 sp of last row of next Square.

Rows 2-7: Work same as Rows 2-7 of Triangle I, referring to diagram for placement of each Triangle and direction of work.

Do NOT fasten off.



TRIANGLE VIII

Work same as Triangle II but do NOT join to neighboring Square at the end of odd-numbered rows.
Do NOT fasten off.

BORDER

Rnd 1: Ch 4, turn, work 2 dc in 3rd ch from hook (beg ch and following 2 dc count as first RV); working in ends of rows across long top edge, *RV in end of next tr/RV row, RV in end of next sc; rep from * across top edge, 3 RV in end of last tr/RV row for corner; working across side edge of Shawl, RV in each ch-sp or end of tr/RV row across side edge, work 5 RV in corner; working across next side edge of Shawl, RV in each ch-sp or end of tr/RV row to beg of rnd, 2 RV in same sp as first RV; join with sl st in top of beg ch-4.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, reach backwards with hook to work sc in sp between last and first RV, *ch 5, sc in next sp between RV sts; rep from * around, ch 5; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 3: Sl st in first 3 ch of first ch-5 sp, ch 1, sc in same ch-5 sp, *ch 5, sc in next ch-5 sp; rep from * around; ch 5; join with sl st in first sc.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Blocking

Dampen Shawl thoroughly. Spread a towel onto a flat surface, then lay Shawl onto towel and smooth into shape. Gently shape Shawl to match finished measurements. Use blocking wires if desired to further shape Shawl. Allow to air dry.
Weave in ends.
