SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: Small, Medium, Large

S (M, L)

Size will vary, depending on thickness of yarn and size hook used.

Note: Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

CORRECTIONS: (applied Feb 27, 2012)

ROSETTE

Ch 17 (35, 53).

Row 1 Dc in 5th ch from hook – **first V-stitch made**, *ch 1, skip 1, (dc-ch-dc) in next ch – V-stitch made; repeat from * across; – **6 7** (16, 25) V-stitches made. Turn.

Row 2 Ch 3 – counts as dc, 5 dc first in ch-space, *sc in next ch-1 space, 6 dc in next ch-1 space – shell st made; repeat from *, ending 6 dc in last ch-1 space – **6 7** (16, 25) shells. Fasten off, leaving long tail for anchoring Rosette.

MATERIALS

- 790-322 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Baroque
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
Pin back or barrette back if desired
Thread and needle to attach to back of Rosette

Note: Alternate color choices as pictured clockwise from top, yarns and colors shown (with suggested LION BRAND crochet hook sizes),

**Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester; package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins*



Homespun #322 Baroque (K-10.5 [6.5 mm])
Microspun #143 Lavender (H-8 [5 mm])
Lion Chenille #113 Garnet (H-8 [5 mm])
Lion Cotton #183 Periwinkle (F-5 [3.75 mm])
Wool-Ease #176 Spring Green (J-10 [6 mm])

GAUGE:

Note Gauge accuracy is not critical. This pattern is all-purpose, and ANY LION BRAND YARN can be used! The thickness of the yarn determines diameter of Rosette. Use the recommended crochet hook size found on the label of your LION BRAND yarn.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size

hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

ROSETTE

Ch 17 (35, 53).

Row 1

Dc in 5th ch from hook – first V-stitch made, *ch 1, skip 1, (dc-ch-dc) in next ch – *V-stitch made*; repeat from * across; – 7 (16, 25) V-stitches made. Turn.

Row 2

Ch 3 – *counts as dc*, 5 dc first in ch-space, *sc in next ch-1 space, 6 dc in next ch-1 space – *shell st made*; repeat from *, ending 6 dc in last ch-1 space – 7 (16, 25) shells. Fasten off, leaving long tail for anchoring Rosette.

FINISHING

Thread needle with tail and weave to base of last st. Starting at that end, roll first shell tightly to form center bud; anchor at base of shell with 2 sts. Roll remaining strip to form Rosette, then secure by stitching in and out through layers of foundation ch at bottom of Rosette. If you want to make your Rosette a pin or barrette, sew or glue pin back or barrette back to back of Rosette.

OPTIONAL VARIATION

2-COLOR ROSETTE

At end of Row 2, work last dc of last shell until 2 loops remain on hook, drop main color, finish st with new color, ch 1, turn.

Row 3

Sc in each st across. Fasten off.
