Knit Hooded Bobble Baby Blanket

Pattern Number: kjif-bobbleBlanket

SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

Approximately 28 in. square

CORRECTIONS: (applied Mar 22, 2006)

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4 in. [10 cm] in seed st.

PATTERN STITCH (mult of 8 sts plus 5):

Rows 1-6: Work in seed st.

Row 7 (RS): Work 2 seed sts, bobble in next st, * work 7 seed sts, bobble in next st*, rep from * to * to last 2 sts, 2 seed sts.

BLANKET:

Cast on 85 sts. Knit 4 rows. Work 1 row seed st.

HOOD:

Cast on 33 sts.

Next row (RS): Work 1 edge st, k2tog, p 1, k 1, P 1, * bobble in next st, 3 seed sts*, rep from * to * to last 3 sts, k2tog, work 1 edge st.

Next row: Work in seed st keeping to pat by starting seed st with p 1. Rep decs after first and before last st on each RS row; ~~AT THE SAME TIME, k 2 rows, then work seed st~~ (keeping first and last edge sts of each row in garter st) until 3 sts rem. Knit 2 rows, binding off loosely across last row.

MATERIALS

- 450-157 Lion Brand Jiffy Yarn:
Pastel Yellow
4 Balls Takes 5 balls for multi-colors
- Lion Brand Knitting Needles -
Size 10.5 [6.5 mm]

Jiffy (Article #450). 100% Acrylic; package size: **Solids (except 151 Dusty Grey): 3 oz./85g; 135 yd/123m balls
Multi (plus 151 Dusty Grey): 2.5 oz./70g; 115 yd/103m balls*



GAUGE:

12 sts = 4 in. [10 cm] in seed st. When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

STITCH EXPLANATION:

Bobble:

Knit into front, back and front of next st, turn, knit 3, turn, p 3, turn, k 3, turn, sl 1 st - k2tog-pass sl st over st just made.

Seed Stitch (over odd number of sts): *K 1, P 1 *, rep from * to * to last st, end k 1.

Rep this row of seed st pat.

PATTERN STITCH (mult of 8 sts plus 5):

Rows 1-6: Work in seed st.

Row 7 (RS): Work 2 seed sts, bobble in next st, *7 seed sts, bobble in next st*, rep from * to * to last 2 sts, 2 seed sts.

Rows 8-12: Work in seed st.

Row 13: Work 6 seed sts, bobble in next st, *7 seed sts, bobble in next st*, rep from * to * to last 6 sts, 6 seed sts. Rep Rows 2-13 for pat.

BLANKET:

Cast on 85 sts. Work 1 row seed st. Keeping first st and last st in k each row for edge st, work 1 row seed st. Rep pat Rows 2-13 until Blanket measures 26½ in or 1½ in. less than desired measurement, ending with pat Row 6 or 12.

Knit 4 rows, binding off loosely across last row.

HOOD:

Cast on 33 sts. Knit 2 rows. Keeping first st and last st in k each row for edge st, work 1 row seed st.

Next row (RS): Work 1 edge st, k2tog, p 1, k 1, P 1, *bobble in next st, 3 seed sts*, rep from * to * to last 3 sts, k2tog, work 1 edge st.

Next row: Work in seed st keeping to pat by starting seed st with p 1. Rep decs after first and before last st on each RS row (keeping first and last edge sts of each row in garter st) until 3 sts rem. Knit 2 rows, binding off loosely across last row.

FINISHING:

Sew hood to blanket with WS tog by placing hood in one corner of the blanket. Weave in ends.
