### Moss-Stitch Afghan

Pattern Number: 10546-C

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** Medium, Large

Afghan 44 inches x 50"

**Throw** 40" x 45"

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

#### **MATERIALS**

- 640-402 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Wheat  
8 (7) Balls
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size P-15 (10 mm)
- Additional Materials

Note 1 full ball is used for fringe.

*\*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon; Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon; Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m) Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m) Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



#### **GAUGE:**

5 sts = 4 inches (10 cm) in pattern st.

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### Making a Gauge Swatch

AFGHAN (Throw)

Ch 55 (51) sts.

**Row 1** Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 54 (50) sc. Turn.

**Row 2 (WS)** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), hdc in 2nd st and in each st across. Turn.

**Row 3** Ch 1, sc in first st, \*sc around front of next st, sc around back of next st; repeat from \* across, sc in last st (turning ch).

**Row 4** Repeat Row 2.

**Row 5** Ch 1, sc in first st, \*sc around back of next st, sc around front of next st; repeat from \* across, sc in last st (turning ch).

Repeat Rows 2-5 for pattern for 50" (45"), ending with pattern Row 3 or 5.

Last Row

Ch 1, sc in each st across. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Fringe (optional)

Wind yarn around 9" piece cardboard and cut strands at one end (18" pieces). Holding 5 strands at a time, fold in half;

insert crochet hook or fingers from back to front and pull middle through to back of afghan or throw. Pull ends through loop and adjust knot. Repeat at base of first and last rows on Afghan or Throw. Trim. **Note** Fringe will use 115 (105) yds. of yarn. If less yarn remains, use 4 strands for fringe to make fringe slightly less full.
