



LION BRAND® WOOL-EASE® THICK & QUICK®
Knit Seaman's Scarf & Vintage Look Hat



Skill Level: Easy +
(If done in round, Hat is Intermediate)

SIZE**Hat** Adult**Scarf** 8 1/2" x 51"**MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND Wool-Ease Thick & Quick
2 balls #152 Pewter or color of your choice
- LION BRAND size 13 (9 mm) knitting needles OR SIZE NEEDED TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- LION BRAND size 13 (9 mm) double-pointed needles (dpns) [if working Hat in the round]
- LION BRAND large-eyed, blunt needle

GAUGE

9 sts = 4" (10 cm) in seed st.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

VINTAGE HAT (worked in the rnd)

With double-pointed needles, cast on 44 sts. Join, taking care not to twist sts.

Rnd 1 *K 1, p 1; repeat from * to last 2 sts, k, (p and k) in last st (= 1-st increase).**Rnd 2** P 1, *k 1, p 1, repeat from * around.**Rnd 3** K 1, *p 1, k 1; repeat from * around.

Repeat Rnds 2 and 3 for seed st until Hat is approximately 11" or desired length to include turn-back brim.

Next Rnd *K3tog, p3tog; repeat from * around to last 3 sts, k3tog. Cut yarn, leaving a 10" tail. Thread tail through large-eyed, blunt needle, run through sts on needle twice to secure, drawing up tight. Weave in ends on inside of Hat.**VINTAGE HAT (worked flat)**

With straight knitting needles, cast on 45 sts.

Row 1 K 1, *p 1, k 1; repeat from * across.

Repeat Row 1 for seed st until Hat is approximately 11" or desired length to include turn-back brim.

New Row *K3tog, p3tog; repeat from * across to within last 3 sts, k3tog. Cut yarn, leaving a 10" tail. Thread tail through large-eyed, blunt needle, run through sts on needle twice to secure, drawing up tight. Weave in end on inside of Hat.**SEAMAN'S SCARF**

With straight knitting needles, cast on 19 sts.

Row 1 K 1, *p 1, k 1; repeat from * across.

Repeat Row 1 for seed st until Scarf is 18" from beg.

Next Row (RS) *(K 2, p 2) twice, k2tog, k 1, (p 2, k 2) twice – 18 sts.**Row 2** P 2, *k 2, p 2; repeat from * across.

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Row 3 K 2, *p 2, k 2; repeat from * across.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until ribbed section is 15" long, ending with Row 2 of ribbing.

Next Row (K 1, p 1) 4 times, (k and p) in next st, (k 1, p 1) 4 times, k 1 – 19 sts. **Next**

Row K 1, *p 1, k 1; repeat from * across.

Repeat last row for seed st for 18". Bind off in pattern. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS:

k = knit	rnd(s) = round(s)
k2tog = knit 2 together	RS = right side
k3tog = knit 3 together	st(s) = stitch(es)
p = purl	tog = together
