MATERIALS

1 Ball

<u>Lion Brand Knitting Needles- Size 9</u>
 [5.5 mm]

• <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles</u> (Set of 6) *<u>Vanna's Choice</u>® (Article #860). 100% Premium Acrylic **400, 401, 403:** 92% Acrylic, 8% Rayon

402: 96% Acrylic, 4% Rayon; package size: **Solids:** 3.5 oz (100 g), 170 yards (156 m) **Prints, Tweeds, & Heathers:** 3 ozs (85 g),

145 yards (133 meters)

Twists: 2.5 oz (70 g), 121 yards (111 meters)



GAUGE:

16 sts + 22 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over knit rows.

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

WRIST WARMERS (make 2)

Cast on 16 sts. Knit the stitches to make one row. Do it again!

Keep knitting rows until the Wrist Warmer is long enough to wrap around your wrist. Bind off, leaving a long yarn tail about 10 in. (25.5 cm). Thread the yarn tail into the blunt needle and sew the ends of the Wrist Warmer together.

If you have 2 colors of yarn, knit some rows with each color to make stripes!
