MATERIALS

- 546-205 [Lion Brand Color Clouds: Ice Storm](#) 1 Ball (A) **Color Clouds (Article #546). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (55yds/50m) pull skeins*
- 546-098 [Lion Brand Color Clouds: Travelers Tan](#) 1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles - Size 19 \[15 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)



GAUGE:

11 sts + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Rows 1 and 2 of pattern.

When you match the [gauge](#) in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

kfb (knit into front and then back)

An increase worked as follows:

1. Knit the next st through the front loop, but do not remove the st from your left hand needle.
2. Knit the same st once more, this time inserting your needle through the back loop of the st. You will have created 2 loops (sts) on your right hand needle.
3. Drop the st from your left hand needle – you have increased 1 st.

NOTES:

1. Scarf is worked in one piece.
2. On every odd-numbered row, you'll work a decrease at the beginning of the row (by knitting 2 sts together) and an increase at the end of the row. The stitch count will not change.
3. Working the increases and decreases creates a diagonal line of color on the Scarf.

SCARF

With A, cast on 11 sts.

Row 1: Knit 2 sts together, k to last st, kfb in last st.

Row 2: Knit.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until almost all A yarn has been used.
Change to B and repeat Rows 1 and 2 until about 1 yd. (1 m) of B yarn remains.
Bind off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
