## Lion Brand® Shawl in a Ball

### Ebb Tide Shawl

Pattern Number: L50172

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 18 x 48 in. (45.5 x 122 cm)

**CORRECTIONS:** (applied Jun 14, 2016)

#### SHAWL

Ch 79.

**Row 1:** Dc in 5th ch from hook (**skipped 4 ch** counts as first dc and first ch 1), \*ch 1, sk 1 ch, dc in next st **ch**; rep across - at the end of this row you will have 39 dc + 38 ch-sps.

#### MATERIALS

- 828-204 Lion Brand Shawl in a Ball: Healing Teal  
1 Ball
  - Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)
  - Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- \*Shawl in a Ball (Article #828). 58% cotton, 39% acrylic, 3% other; package size: 5.30oz/150.00 gr. (481yds/440m) pull skeins*



#### GAUGE:

9 dc + 8 ch-sp = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

Shawl is worked back and forth in one piece.

#### SHAWL

Ch 79.

**Row 1:** Dc in 5th ch from hook (skipped 4 ch counts as first dc and first ch 1), \*ch 1, sk 1 ch, dc in next ch; rep across – at the end of this row you will have 39 dc + 38 ch-sps.

**Row 2:** Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch 1), turn, \*dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from \* across to ch-4 sp, dc in turning ch.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 48 in. (122 cm) from beg, or until almost all yarn has been used. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

### Blocking

Dampen Shawl thoroughly. Spread a towel onto a flat surface, then lay Shawl onto towel and smooth into shape. Gently shape Shawl to match finished measurements. Use blocking wires if desired to further shape Shawl. Allow to air dry.

Weave in ends.
