SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 20 x 50 in. (51 x 127 cm), before folding and seaming

MATERIALS

- 546-098 Lion Brand Color Clouds: Travelers Tan
2 Balls (A) **Color Clouds (Article #546). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.50oz/100.00 gr. (55yds/50m) pull skeins*
- 546-204 Lion Brand Color Clouds: Thunder
5 Balls (B)
- Lion Brand Size 19 [15 mm] 29-inch [75 cm] Circular Knitting Needles
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)



GAUGE:

7 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) in St st (k on RS, p on WS).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

PATTERN STITCH

Seed St (worked over an even number of sts)

Row 1: *K1, p1; repeat from * across.

Row 2: K the purl sts and p the knit sts.

Repeat Row 2 for Seed st.

NOTES:

1. Poncho is worked in one piece in St st (K on RS, p on WS) with contrast color Seed st borders.
2. Following a diagram, piece is folded and seamed to make Poncho.
3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large stitches. Work back and forth in rows on the circular needle just as if working on straight needles.

PONCHO

With A, cast on 34 sts.

Work in Seed st for 13 rows.

Change to B.

With B, and beg with a RS (knit) row, work in St st (k on RS, p on WS) until piece measures about 45 in. (114 cm) from beg, ending with a WS (purl) row as the last row you work.

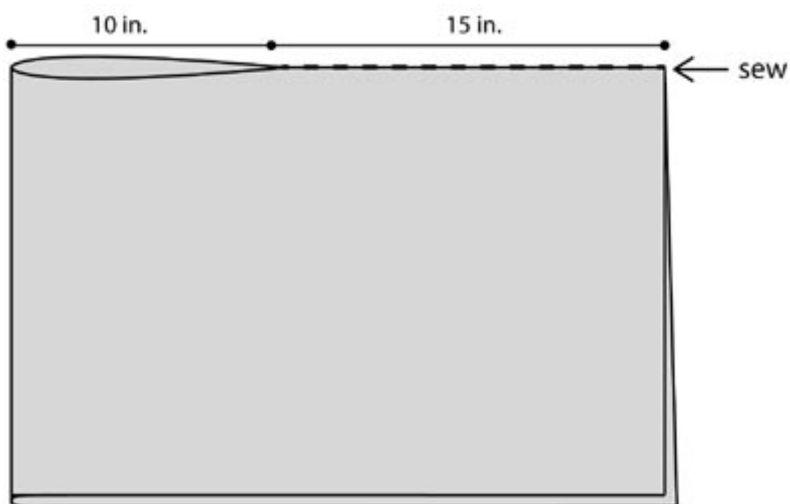
Change to A and work in Seed st for 13 rows.

Bind off.

FINISHING

Following diagram, fold piece in half. Sew long edges together for 15 in. (38 cm), leaving remaining edges unsewn for neck.

Weave in ends.
