

SIZE: One Size


About 33 x 38 in. (84 x 96.5 cm) before folding and seaming

#### **MATERIALS**

 866-109 <u>Lion Brand Vanna's</u> <u>Complement: Colonial Blue</u>
 5 Balls

- <u>Lion Brand Crochet Hook Size K-</u> 10.5 (6.5 mm)
- <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt</u> <u>Needles (Set of 6)</u>



#### **GAUGE:**

12 hdc + 7 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm)

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### STITCH EXPLANATION:

V-st (V-stitch) Work (dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st or sp.

#### **NOTES:**

- 1. A simple rectangle is crocheted, then folded and seamed to make the Shrug.
- 2. We used a larger hook than specified on yarn label to create a Shrug that drapes in a flattering way.

#### **SHRUG**

Ch 99.

Row 1: Hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across - you will have 98 hdc.

Rows 2 and 3: Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in back loop only of each st across, hdc in top of beg ch.

**Row 4:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in back loop only of next 6 sts, sk next st, 3 dc in both loops of next st, \*sk next 2 sts, 3 dc in both loops of next st; rep from \* to last 8 sts, sk next st, hdc in back loop only of next 6 sts, hdc in top of beg ch – Twenty-eight 3-dc groups.

**Row 5:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in back loop only of next 6 sts, V-st in center dc of each 3-dc group to last 7 sts, hdc in back loop only of next 6 sts, hdc in top of beg ch – 28 V-sts.

**Row 6:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in back loop only of next 6 sts, 3 dc in ch-1 sp of each V-st to last 7 sts, hdc in back loop only of next 6 sts, hdc in top of beg ch – Twenty-eight 3-dc groups.

**Row 7:** Ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in back loop only of next 6 sts, hdc in both loops of each st to last 7 sts, hdc in back loop only of next 6 sts, hdc in in top of beg ch – 98 sts.


Rows 8-61: Rep Rows 2-7 nine more times.

**Rows 62 and 63:** Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Fasten off.

#### **FINISHING**

Following diagram, fold piece in half to measure  $16\ 1/2\ x\ 38$  in.  $(42\ x\ 96.5\ cm)$ . Place markers on each of the 21 in.  $(53.5\ cm)$  sides, 7 in.  $(18\ cm)$  below fold for armholes. Sew sides from markers down to lower edge. Weave in ends.
