## • <u>Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles</u> (Set of 6)

11 hdc + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm).

When you match the <u>gauge</u> in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

## Making a Gauge Swatch

- 1. 3 Panels are made separately, then sewn together following a diagram to make the Afghan.
- 2. Each Panel is worked back and forth in rows, changing yarn color to make blocks and strips of color.
- 3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete the st. Proceed with new color. Cut old color.



With A, ch 30.

With A, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 29 hdc at the end of this row.

With A, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st across, hdc in top of beg ch and change to B in last st of Row 16.

Rep Row 2 and change color as in the following color sequence: Work 16 rows with B, 24 rows with C, 20 rows with D, and 24 rows with E.

Fasten off.

From RS, join F with sl st in A-colored corner so that you are ready to work across the long edge.

With F, ch 1, work 138 sts evenly spaced across long edge, working 22 sc along A-colored edge, 22 sc along B-colored edge, 33 sc along C-colored edge, 28 sc along D-colored edge, and 33 sc along E-colored edge.

With F, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st across, hdc in top of beg ch.

With F, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across working last sc in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

With F, ch 42.

With F, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 41 hdc at the end of this row.

With F, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st across, hdc in top of beg ch and change to G in last st of Row 20.

Rep Row 2 and change color as in the following color sequence: Work 24 rows with G, 28 rows with H, 16 rows with I, and 12 rows with J.

Change to N in last st of last row.

With N, ch 1, do not turn, work 17 sc evenly spaced along J-colored edge, 22 sc along I-colored edge, and 38 sc along H-colored edge and change to I in last of these sts; with I, work 33 sc along G-colored edge, and 28 sc along F-colored edge - 138 sts.

With I, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each I-colored st and change to N in last of these sts; with N, hdc in each N-colored st working last st in top of beg ch.

With N, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each N-colored st and change to I in last of these sts; with I, hdc in each I-colored st working last st in top of beg ch.

Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Rep Row 2.

With N, ch 1, turn, sc in each N-colored st and change to I in last of these sts; with I, sc in each I-colored st working last sc in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.

From RS, join J with sl st in F-colored corner.

With J, ch 1, work 28 sc evenly spaced along F-colored edge, 33 sc along G-colored edge, and 38 sc along H-colored edge and change to C in last of these sts; with C, work 22 sc along I-colored edge, and 17 sc along J-colored edge – 138 sts.

With C, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each C-colored st and change to J in last of these sts; with J, hdc in each J-colored st working last st in top of beg ch.

With J, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each J-colored st and change to N in last of these sts; with N, hdc in each N-colored st working last st in top of beg ch.

Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Rep Row 2.

With J, ch 1, turn, sc in each J-colored st and change to C in last of these sts; with C, sc in each C-colored st working last sc in top of beg ch. Fasten off.

With K, ch 30.

With K, hdc in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped ch count as first hdc) and in each ch across – you will have 29 hdc at the end of this row.

With K, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st across, hdc in top of beg ch and change to L in last st of Row 12.

Rep Row 2 and change color as in the following color sequence: Work 16 rows with L, 32 rows with M, 24 rows with N, and 16 rows with O.

Fasten off.

From RS, join A with sl st in O-colored corner so that you are ready to work across the long edge.

With A, ch 1, work 138 sc evenly spaced across long edge, working 22 sc along O-colored edge, 33 sc along N-colored edge, 44 sc along M-colored edge, 22 sc along L-colored edge, and 17 sc along K-colored edge – 138 sts.

With A, ch 2 (counts as hdc), turn, sk first st, hdc in each st across, hdc in top of beg ch.

With A, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across working last sc in top of beg ch.

Fasten off.


Following diagram, sew Panels together to make the Afghan.

From RS, join matching color yarn in any corner so that you are ready to work across a side edge of Afghan.

Ch 1, work so evenly spaced across side edge, changing yarn color as you work to match the colors of the edge. Fasten off

Rep to work side border along opposite side edge.

Weave in ends.
