- 635-171 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Fern
1 Ball (C)
- 635-108 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Lapis
1 Ball (D)
- 635-105 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Caribbean Blue
1 Ball (E)
- 635-143 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Lavender
1 Ball (F)
- 635-187 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Buttercup
2 Balls (G)
- 635-113 Lion Brand Wool-Ease Tonal: Vermillion

GAUGE:

11 sts + 20 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Garter st (k every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. 48 Triangles (24 each of Left and Right Triangles) are worked separately, then sewn together following a diagram to make the Afghan.
2. Triangles are worked in Garter st (k every row), changing yarn color to make stripes.
3. Half of the Triangles are worked in dark shades and half in bright. All yarn colors are used as desired - have fun placing your favorite shades together!
4. The pattern gives instruction for the basic Triangles, specific directions for striping follow.



LEFT TRIANGLE

With first color, cast on 20 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every row) for 3 rows.

Next Row: Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Rep last 4 rows until 3 sts remain. Bind off.

RIGHT TRIANGLE

With first color, cast on 20 sts.

Work in Garter st (knit every row) for 3 rows.

Next Row: K1, k2tog, k to end of row.
Rep last 4 rows until 3 sts remain. Bind off.

BRIGHT SHADES TRIANGLES

Use yarn colors A-H as desired.

Left Stripe Sequence (make 12)

Cast on with first color.

Follow instructions for Left Triangle, working stripes as follows:

Rows 1 and 2: First color.

Rows 3 and 4: Second color.

Rows 5 and 6: First color.

Rows 7 and 8: Second color.

Rows 9 and 10: First color.

Rows 11-20: Second color.

Rows 21 and 22: Third color.

Rows 23 and 24: Second color.

Rows 25 and 26: Third color.

Rows 27 and 28: Second color.

Rows 29 and 30: Third color.

Rows 31 and 32: Second color.

Continue with third color.

Right Stripe Sequence (make 12)

Cast on with first color.

Follow instructions for Right Triangle, repeating left stripe sequence.

DARK SHADES TRIANGLES

Use yarn colors I-M as desired.

Left Stripe Sequence (make 12)

Cast on with first color.

Follow instructions for Left Triangle, working stripes as follows:

Rows 1-8: First color.

Rows 9 and 10: Second color.

Rows 11 and 12: First color.

Rows 13 and 14: Second color.

Rows 15 and 16: First color.

Rows 17-28: Second color.

Rows 29 and 30: Third color.

Rows 31 and 32: Second color.

Rows 33 and 34: Third color.

Rows 35 and 36: Second color.

Continue with third color.

Right Stripe Sequence (make 12)

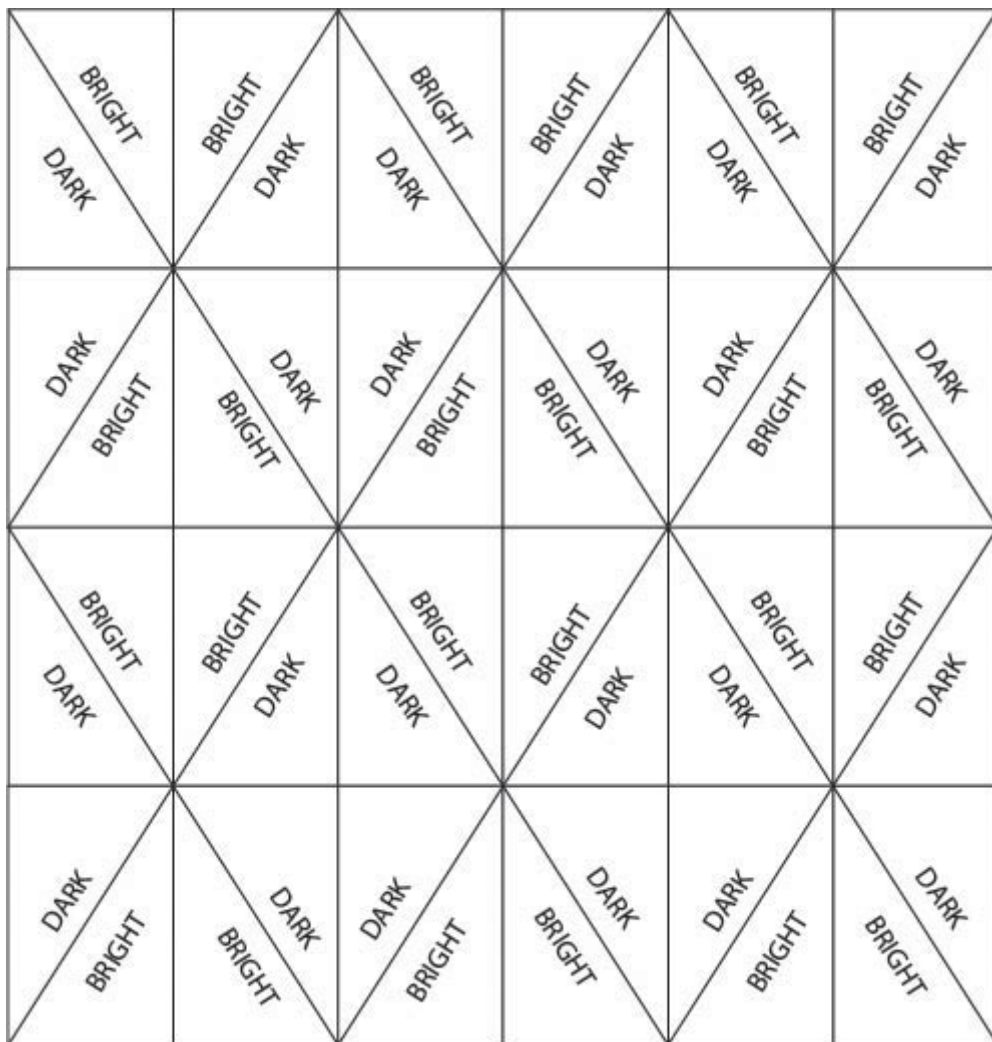
Cast on with first color.

Follow instructions for Right Triangle, repeating left stripe sequence.

FINISHING

Following Assembly Diagram, sew Triangles together to make Afghan.

Weave in ends.
