SKILL LEVEL: Easy (Level 2)

SIZE: One Size

About 7 x 15 in. (18 x 38 cm), after folding and seaming

MATERIALS

- 790-600 Lion Brand Homespun Yarn: Clouds
1 Ball
- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size H-8 (5 mm)
- Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
Sewing needle and thread
9 x 12 in. (23 x 30.5 cm)
piece of felt
24 in. (61 cm) length of
purchased metal chain

**Homespun® (Article #790). 98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester;
package size: 6.00oz/170.00 gr. (185yds/169m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

STITCH EXPLANATION:

7-dc Puff Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops, (yarn over, insert hook into SAME st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) 6 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

6-dc Puff Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops, (yarn over, insert hook into SAME st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) 5 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

5-dc Puff Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops, (yarn over, insert hook into SAME st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) 4 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

4-dc Puff Yarn over, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops, (yarn over, insert hook into SAME st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) 3 times, yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

NOTES:

1. Muff is worked in one piece, then folded and seamed.
2. A felt pouch is made separately, then sewed into Muff. If desired, add a tie or button closure to the open top of the pouch.

MUFF
Puff Half

Ch 24.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 23 sts.

Row 2 and all wrong side rows: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first sc, *7-dc puff in next st, sc in next sc; rep from * to end of row – 11 puffs.

Rows 5, 7 and 9: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, *6-dc puff in next st, sc in next sc; rep from * across.

Rows 11, 13 and 15: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, *5-dc puff in next st, sc in next sc; rep from * across.

Row 17: Ch 1, turn, sc in first sc, *4-dc puff in next st, sc in next sc; rep from * to across.

Sc Half Row 18: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Rep Row 18 until sc half of Muff measures same length as puff half.

Fasten off.

Cuffs

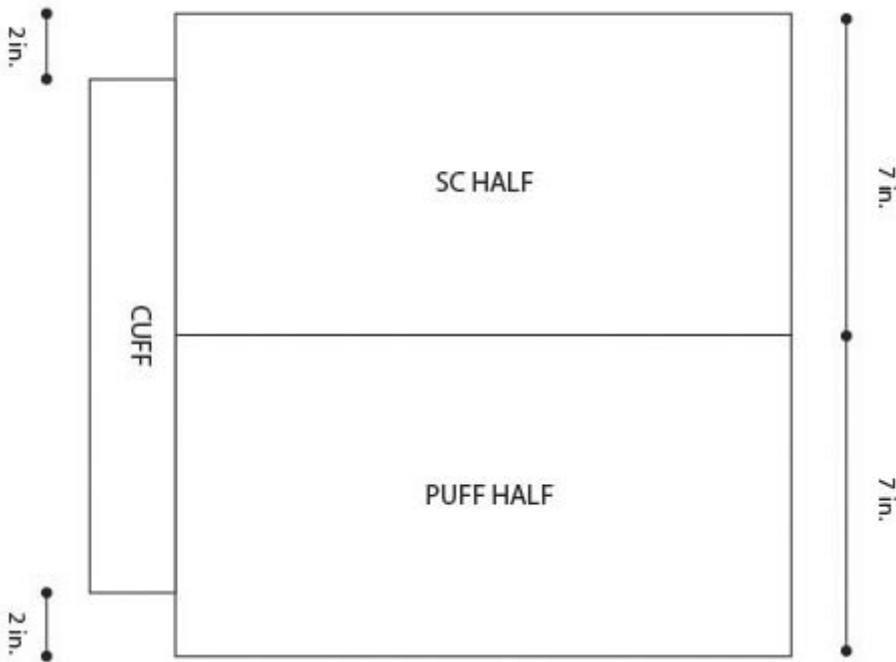
Following Diagram 1, place markers on side edge of piece, 2 in. (5 cm) from first and last rows.

From RS, join yarn with a sl st at marker. Work 23 sc evenly spaced to next marker.

Rows 1-5: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Fasten off.

Work same cuff on opposite side of Muff.

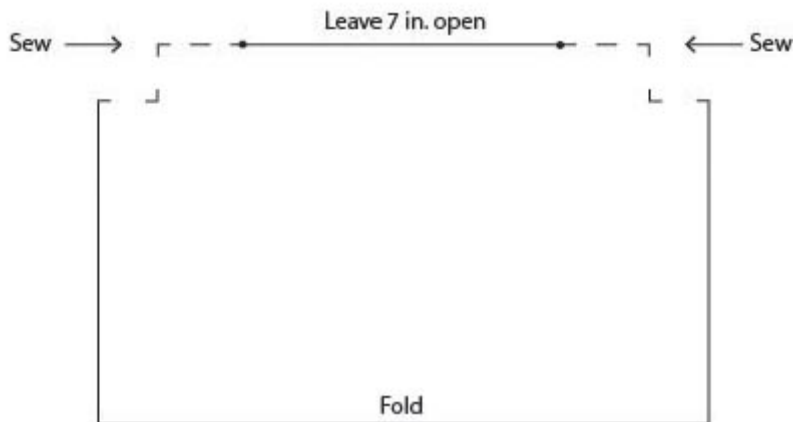


FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Following Diagram 2, fold piece in half, then sew upper edge of cuff, side edge of Muff, and top edges of Muff for 2 in. (10 cm).

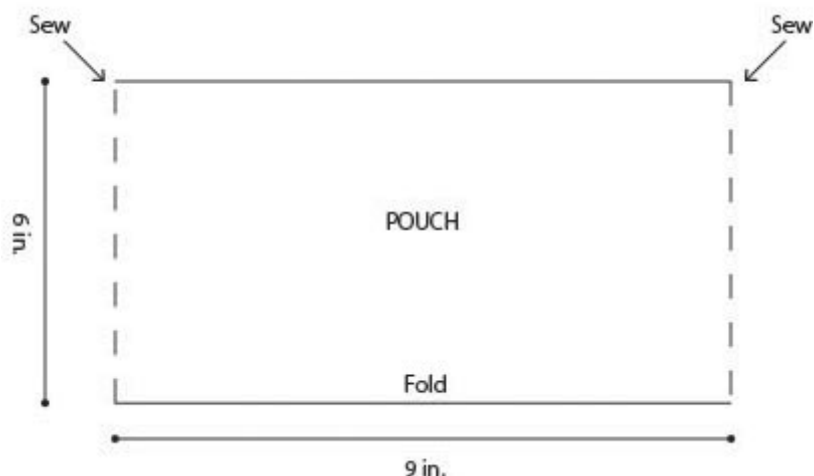
Rep for opposite side of Muff.



Inner Pouch

Following Diagram 3, fold felt in half to make a 6 x 9 in. (15 x 23 cm) piece. With sewing needle and thread, sew the 6 in. (15 cm) sides together.

Slip the felt pouch into the Muff. With sewing needle and thread, sew the top edges of the Muff and pouch together.



Chain Strap

With sewing needle and thread, sew ends of chain to top of Muff.

If desired, weave a length of yarn in and out of the chain links.
