MATERIALS

- 546-205 Lion Brand Color Clouds: Ice Storm
2 Balls (A)
*Color Clouds (Article #546). 100% Acrylic; package size:
3.50oz/100.00 gr. (55yds/50m) pull skeins
- 546-098 Lion Brand Color Clouds: Travelers Tan
2 Balls (B)
- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)
- Additional Materials
Smooth, thin yarn for sewing



GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.

NOTES:

1. Yarns are made into 10 braids; braids are sewn together to make the Cowl.
2. Follow the pattern and diagrams to make your Cowl – or make as many or as few braids as you like to make a custom cowl.

BRAID 1

Cut 6 strands of A, each about 31 in. (78.5 cm). Tie all strands together into an overhand knot, about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from one end.

Divide strands into 3 groups of 2 strands each and braid until about 3 in. (cm) from opposite end.

Tie strands together with an overhand knot. Do not trim yarn ends yet.

BRAID 2

Cut 4 strands of A, each about 38 in. (96.5 cm). Tie all strands together into an overhand knot, about 4 in. (10 cm) from one end.

Braid strands until about 4 in. (10 cm) from opposite end.

Tie strands together with an overhand knot. Do not trim yarn ends yet.

BRAID 3

Cut 16 strands of A, each about 43 in. (109 cm). Tie all strands together into an overhand knot, about 6 in. (15 cm) from one end.

Divide strands into 4 groups of 4 strands each and braid until about 6 in. (15 cm) from opposite end.

Tie strands together with an overhand knot. Do not trim yarn ends yet.

BRAID 4

Cut 18 strands of A, each about 35 in. (89 cm). Tie all strands together into an overhand knot, about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from one end.

Divide strands into 3 groups of 6 strands each and braid until about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from opposite end.

Tie strands together with an overhand knot. Do not trim yarn ends yet.

BRAID 5

Cut 9 strands of A, each about 38 in. (96.5 cm). Tie all strands together into an overhand knot, about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from one end.

Divide strands into 3 groups of 3 strands each and braid until about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from opposite end.

Tie strands together with an overhand knot. Do not trim yarn ends yet.

BRAID 6

Cut 4 strands of A, each about 34 in. (86.5 cm). Tie all strands together into an overhand knot, about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from one end.

Braid strands together until about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from opposite end.

Tie strands together with an overhand knot. Do not trim yarn ends yet.

BRAID 7

Cut 12 strands of B, each about 37 in. (94 cm). Tie all strands together into an overhand knot, about 4 in. (10 cm) from one end.

Divide strands into 3 groups of 4 strands each and braid until about 4 in. (10 cm) from opposite end.

Tie strands together with an overhand knot. Do not trim yarn ends yet.

BRAID 8

Cut 6 strands of B, each about 37 in. (94 cm). Tie all strands together into an overhand knot, about 4 in. (10 cm) from one end.

Divide strands into 3 groups of 2 strands each and braid until about 4 in. (10 cm) from opposite end.

Tie strands together with an overhand knot. Do not trim yarn ends yet.

BRAID 9

Cut 6 strands of B, each about 38 in. (96.5 cm). Tie all strands together into an overhand knot, about 4 in. (10 cm) from one end.

Divide strands into 3 groups of 2 strands each and braid until about 4 in. (10 cm) from opposite end.

Tie strands together with an overhand knot. Do not trim yarn ends yet.

BRAID 10

Cut 4 strands of A, each about 42 in. (106.5 cm). Tie all strands together into an overhand knot, about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from one end.

Braid strands together until about 3 in. (7.5 cm) from opposite end.


Tie strands together with an overhand knot. Do not trim yarn ends yet.




STEP 3

Assembly

With smooth yarn threaded into blunt needle, and following diagram, whipstitch adjoining edges of Braids together as follows:

- Sew upper edge of Braid 1 to lower edge of Braid 2.
- Sew upper edge of Braid 2 to lower edge of Braid 3.
- Sew upper edge of Braid 3 to lower edge of Braid 4.
- Sew upper edge of Braid 4 to lower edge of Braid 5.
- Sew upper edge of Braid 5 to lower edge of Braid 7.
- Sew Braid 6 over the seam between Braids 5 and 7.
- Sew upper edge of Braid 7 to lower edge of Braid 8.
- Sew upper edge of Braid 8 to lower edge of Braid 9.
- Sew upper edge of Braid 9 to lower edge of Braid 10.



FINISHING

Trim yarn ends as desired.
