### Faux Fur Stole

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** One Size

About 8 x 33 in. (20.5 x 84 cm)

#### MATERIALS

- 321-203 [Lion Brand Pelt: Fisher](#) 4 Balls *\*Pelt (Article #321). 68% Nylon, 32% Polyester; package size: 1.75oz/50.00 gr. (47yds/43m) pull skeins*
- [Lion Brand Knitting Needles Size 11 \[8 mm\]](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)



#### GAUGE:

15 sts = about 4 in. (10cm) in Garter st (k every row).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

#### NOTES:

Stole is worked in one piece in Garter st (k every row) with simple decreases on one end.

#### STOLE

Cast on 30 sts.

Work in Garter st (k every row) until piece measures about 26 in. (66 cm) from beginning.

#### Shape End

**Row 1:** K2tog, k to end of row – you will have 29 sts at the end of Row 1.

**Row 2:** Knit.

**Rows 3-10:** Repeat Rows 1 and 2 four times – 25 sts at the end of Row 10.

**Row 11:** K2tog, k to end of row – 24 sts.

**Row 12:** K to last 2 sts, k2tog – 23 sts.

Repeat Rows 11 and 12 until you have 7 sts.

Bind off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends.
