MATERIALS

- 866-098 Lion Brand Vanna's Complement: Fisherman

1 Ball (A)

- 866-108 Lion Brand Vanna's Complement: Dusty Blue

3 Balls (B)

- Lion Brand Crochet Hook - Size J-10 (6 mm)

- Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles (Set of 6)

**Vanna's Complement (Article #866). 100% Acrylic; package size: 3.00oz/85.00 gr. (185yds/170m) pull skeins*



GAUGE:

12 hdc + 8 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm)

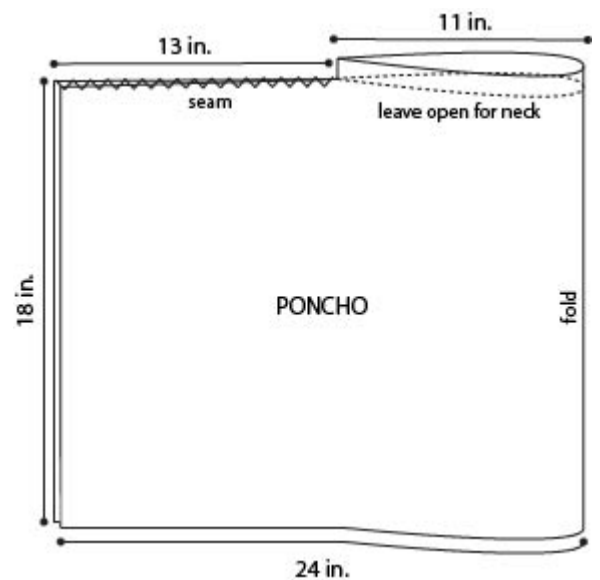
When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

Making a Gauge Swatch

NOTES:

1. Poncho is made from a folded and seamed simple crochet rectangle.
2. Poncho rectangle begins and ends with alternating rows of dc and sc worked with A. Center of Poncho is worked in rows of hdc with B.
3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

PONCHO

First A-Colored Section

With A, ch 56.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc) and in each ch across – you will have 54 dc at the end of this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, sc in each st across working last sc in top of beg ch.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, sk first st, dc in each st across.

Rows 4 and 5: Rep Rows 2 and 3.

Row 6: Rep Row 2 and change to B in last st.

Note: A-colored section will measure about 3 in. (7.5 cm).

B-Colored Section

Row 7: With B, ch 2 (does not count as a st), turn, hdc in each st across.

Rep Row 7 until piece measures about 45 in. (114.5 cm) from beg.

Change to A in last st of last row worked.

Second A-Colored Section

Next Row: With A, ch 1, turn, sc in each st across.

Next Row: With A, rep Row 3.

Next 4 Rows: With A, rep Rows 2 and 3 twice more.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Fold piece in half, bringing first and last row together, to measure 18 x 24 in. (45.5 x 61 cm). Place a marker on one of the 24 in. (61 cm) sides, 11 in. (28 cm) from fold for neck opening.

Seam edge from marker to corner.

Neck Edging

From RS, join B with sl st at neck edge seam.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 66 sc spaced evenly around neck edge; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends.
