## Lion Brand® Wool-Ease® Thick & Quick®

### Camano Island Topper

Pattern Number: L50260

**SKILL LEVEL:** Easy (Level 2)

**SIZE:** XS/S, M/L, 1X/2X

**Finished Bust** About 42 (50, 58) in. (106.5 (127, 147.5) cm)

**Finished Length** About 23 (24, 25) in. (58.5 (61, 63.5) cm), not including turtleneck

**Note:** Pattern is written for smallest size with changes for larger sizes in parentheses. When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. To follow pattern more easily, circle all numbers pertaining to your size before beginning.

#### MATERIALS

- 640-154 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Grey Marble](#)  
3 4, 5 Balls (A)
- 640-155 [Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick Yarn: Obsidian](#)  
1 1, 1 Ball (B)
- [Lion Brand Size 13 \[9 mm\] 29-inch \[75 cm\] Circular Knitting Needles](#)
- [Lion Brand Split Ring Stitch Markers](#)
- [Lion Brand Large-Eye Blunt Needles \(Set of 6\)](#)
- Additional Materials  
Crochet hook, any size from C-K, for fringe

*\*Wool-Ease Thick & Quick (Article #640). Solids, Heathers, Twists, Prints, Stripes: 80% Acrylic, 20% Wool; Wheat & Wood: 86% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 4% Rayon; Oatmeal & Barley & Grey Marble: 82% Acrylic; 10% Wool; 8% Rayon; Metallics: 79% Acrylic, 20% Wool, 1% Metallic Poly; package size: Solids, Heathers, Twists, Tweeds: 6 oz./170g (106 yd/97 m) Prints, Stripes: 5 oz./140g (87 yd/80 m) Metallics: 5 oz./140g (92 yd/84 m)*



#### GAUGE:

8 sts + 12 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) in Reverse St st (p on RS, k on WS).

When you match the gauge in a pattern, your project will be the size specified in the pattern and the materials specified in the pattern will be sufficient. The needle or hook size called for in the pattern is based on what the designer used, but it is not unusual for gauge to vary from person to person. If it takes you fewer stitches and rows to make your swatch, try using a smaller size hook or needles; if more stitches and rows, try a larger size hook or needles.

#### NOTES:

1. Topper is worked in 2 pieces, Front and Back.
2. Both pieces are worked changing yarn color following a Stripe Sequence.
3. A circular needle is used to accommodate the large number of sts. Work back and forth on the circular needle as if working on straight needles.
4. End with a WS row means that the last row you work should be a WS row, and the next row that you are ready to work will be a RS row.
5. When you see '- 12 sts' in the instructions, this lets you know how many sts you will have at the end of that specific row.

## Camano Island Topper made with Wool...



### STRIPE SEQUENCE

Work 10 rows with A, 2 rows with B.  
Rep these 12 rows for Stripe Sequence.

### FRONT

With A, cast on 42 (50, 58) sts.

Beg with a WS (knit) row, work in Reverse St st (p on RS, k on WS) changing color following Stripe Sequence until piece measures about 21 (22, 23) in. (53.5 (56, 58.5) cm) from beg, end with WS row as the last row you work.

### Shape Shoulders

Continuing in Reverse St st and Stripe Sequence, bind off 3 (5, 6) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then bind off 4 (4, 5) sts at beg of following 2 rows – 22 (22, 24) sts.

### Turtleneck

Continue in Stripe Sequence and Reverse St st over 22 (22, 24) sts for 12 rows. Bind off.

### BACK

Work same as Front.

### FINISHING

Sew shoulders and sides of turtleneck.

### Armbands

Place markers on side edges of Front and Back about 9 (10, 11) in. (23 (25.5, 28) cm) below shoulders.

From RS with A, pick up and k36 (40, 44) sts evenly spaced between markers.

Purl 1 row, knit 1 row.

Bind off.

Fold armband to WS. With B, whipstitch through all thicknesses around armholes to hold armband in place.

Rep on opposite side.

Sew sides of Topper from armholes down to 5 in. (12.5 cm) above lower edge.

### Embroidery

With B, whipstitch around neck and lower edges of Front and Back.

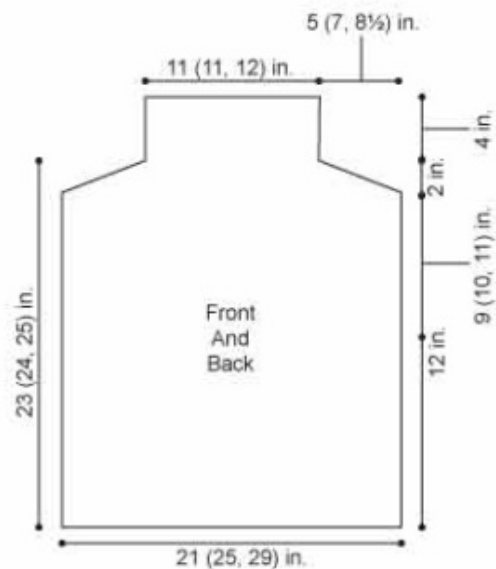
With B, whipstitch along both sides of seams on turtleneck, shoulders and sides.

Weave in ends.

### Fringes

Cut 84 (100, 116) strands of A about 12 in. (30.5 cm) long. For each fringe, fold 1 strand in half. Use crochet hook to draw fold through edge of Topper, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop. Pull to tighten. Make 42 (50, 58) fringes evenly spaced across lower edge of Back and 42 (50, 58) fringes across lower edge of Front.

Trim fringe ends evenly.
